For Business Owners

- Verify Numbers When you take an order, do a call back and verify the number is good. This can also be done by having Caller ID.
- Verify the Address Check the address with past orders.

 Keeping detailed records is important.
- **Cash limits** Display and enforce cash limits for all drivers.
- **Credit Car Payments** Encourage callers to pay via credit card
- **Use GPS** Having drivers use GPS can help locate them if there is an emergency.
- **Use Cameras** in-car camera systems can record activities if an incident should occur.
- Cell Phones Provide cell phones to drivers to let them stay in contact and to call 911 if they come across an emergency.
- Suspicious Orders Train employees how to ID suspicious orders (caller sounds intoxicated, caller does not know address or phone number, caller stumbles through details they should know, caller does not appear interested in the order or how much the order costs.)



For Delivery Drivers

- Trust your gut instinct If something does not feel right, stay in your car and leave the area. Return to the shop or a nearby safe area.
- Be aware of people that may be following you, take note of vehicle description and alert the police.
- Pay attention to your surroundings and do not let yourself be distracted by the radio or cell phone.
- If you get to a location that is not lit, have a call back made to turn on lights before you deliver.
- Carry a flashlight to help you to help light dark areas.
- If someone approaches you, keep them at arm's length.
- Use your headlights to help illuminate your delivery area.
- Report suspicious activity to the police when it is safe to do so.
- Do not carry large amounts of cash.
