**Resolution Opposing Short-Term Rental Legislation
(HB 4722)**

WHEREAS, the County of Alger receives a substantial number of visitors and tourists requiring a range of lodging options; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Alger recognizes the importance of enhancing residential neighborhoods, while balancing the needs and wants of visitors; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Alger believes that local governments are best positioned to know the unique needs of a community and determine the delicate balance between residential and commercial uses, and between residents and investment property owners; and


WHEREAS, HB 4722 would eliminate the ability of local governments to regulate short-term rentals in residential neighborhoods, ultimately lowering housing standards for communities throughout Michigan.

THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the Alger County Board of Commissioners, in an effort to help retain local control for the ability of local governments to regulate short term rental of residential properties, opposes HB 4722 and urges its representatives to do the same.
