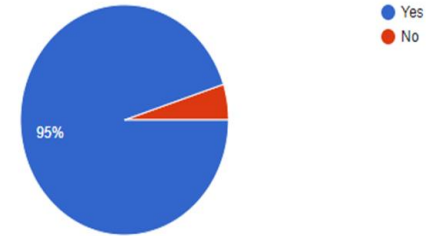
1. ACPS should seek funding for a work-based learning coordinator.

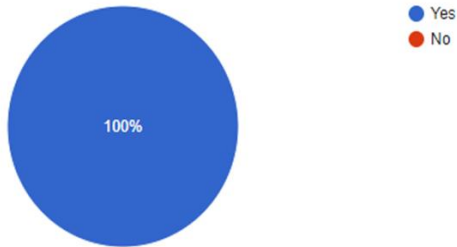

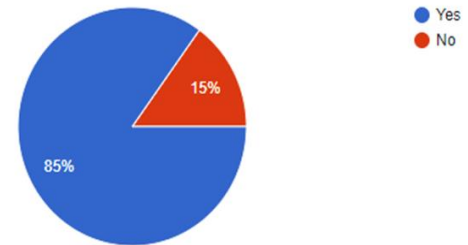

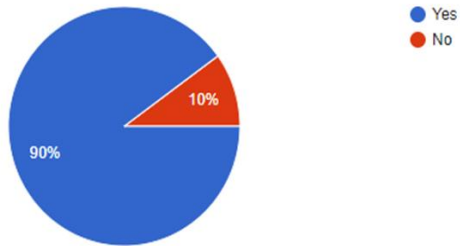

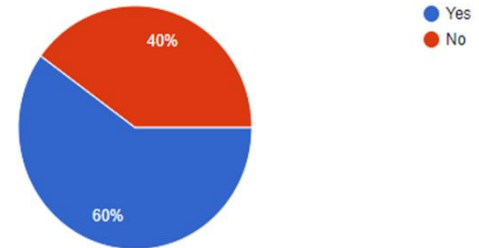

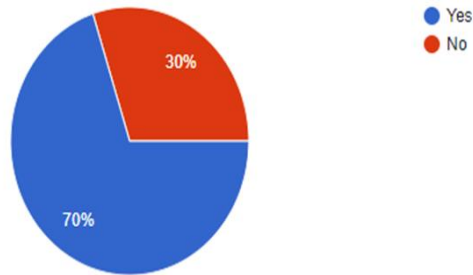

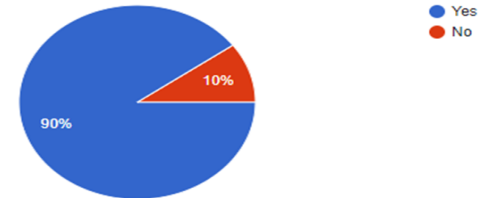
7. ACPS should add the following CTE program to ACPS CTE offerings, based on student survey data: STEM (Science-Technology-Engineering-Math)

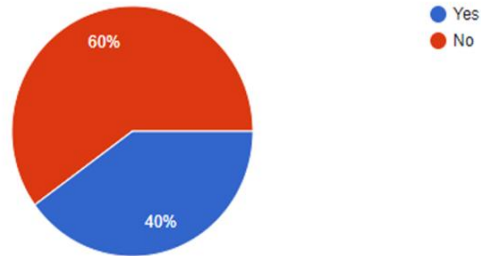

9. ACPS should continue to operate Amelia Nottoway Technical Center (ANTC) CTE programs including: Auto Body, Cosmetology, Culinary Arts, Medical Assistant, and Nurse Aide at a cost of approximately \$6,388.71 per student.

Recommendations from the CTE Committee Task Force

- Seek Funding for a Work-Based Learning Coordinator
- Build a new CTE building/facility adjacent to ACHS
- Move CTE programs from ANTC to ACHS in Fall 2024
(AutoBody, Cosmetology, Culinary Arts, Medical Assistant, Nurse Aide)

Recommendations from the CTE Committee Task Force

- Continue CTE partnership with Brightpoint C.C. (formerly JTCC)
- Continue existing CTE program offerings at ACHS
- Consider eventually adding new CTE programs to ACHS
(Automotive Technology, Criminal Justice, EMT, Sports Medicine, STEM)
- Request a joint meeting between ACPS School Board and Amelia County Board of Supervisors

PLACEMENT OPTIONS FOR ANTC PROGRAMS

Option 1

Remain with ANTC



- No additional costs other than continued budgeting for additional programs
- High PPE with less opportunity to increase cost effectiveness of programs
- Considerable work required to continue to recruit students to travel to ANTC to maintain/increase enrollment

Option 2

Renovate ACPS



- Renovate white building by SBO for auto shop
- Renovate 6-8 ACMS classrooms for CTE classrooms
- Culinary returns to SBO
- Options limited by budget of \$1,389,924 in state construction funding
- Uses remaining space in ACPS buildings, leaving almost no room to accommodate growth in enrollment
- Requires continued--albeit reduced--transportation

Option 3

Build a new Facility for ACPS CTE



- Will require additional county funding to supplement state construction funding available
- Location: aside ACHS auditorium and extended parking lot, limiting need for transportation for ACHS students
- Construction: prefabricated metal building to minimize construction costs

*Options 2 and 3 will require additional "start-up" costs to equip and grow programs on the ACPS campus beyond regular operating budgets. Adding staff/programs will be more expensive.
