// Introduction

Amelia County, Virginia, renowned for its rich heritage and natural beauty, stands poised for transformative growth. Our proposed budget aims to strategically utilize both video and photography in initiatives to bolster both Amelia County business and tourism, with the goal of the community flourishing while preserving the charm and character that make Amelia County unique. With this budget and the media Red Velocity captures, we will work to attract new businesses and grow tourism with the purpose of increasing Amelia County as a destination of choice for visitors near and far.

// Strategy

Creating a compelling strategy to showcase Amelia County, Virginia, using video and photography can greatly enhance its appeal to businesses and tourists. Our plan to achieve this is executed in three phases - **Pre-production**, **production**, **and post production**.

- **1. Pre-Production** Utilizing research/zoom communication with Amelia County officials, our Red Velocity creative writer/brand strategist will help develop the story and create pointed questions for strategically selected people we interview. These elements come together to tell the Amelia County business and tourism stories. This research will identify unique aspects of Amelia County that set it apart.
- **2. Production Days of filming/photography:** In phase 2, we apply our research and planning through filming and photography. We will focus our video and photography on Amelia tourism (horseback riding, fishing, kayaking) and businesses and craftsmanship surrounding the Amelia Day Festival while capturing historical sites, natural landscapes, cultural events, and local businesses. We will follow a video and photography "shot list" that aligns with our script and overall creative strategy. We suggest incorporating drone video, ground video b-roll, and interviews with local residents and business owners to add depth and authenticity to the content. We will utilize multiple cinematic cameras, drones, steadicam gimbals, professional lighting and sound to accomplish our goals. In our

business interviews we will capture true craftsmanship in woodworking (or another craft Amelia staff decides on) featuring interviews with local craftsmen, entrepreneurs and business leaders to provide firsthand insights into how great Amelia County is. Farming can also be a component we capture. Our interviews should evoke emotions of community pride and belonging.

3. Post Production - Editing - Once all the visual assets are captured we move on to phase 3, editing. For video, Red Velocity blends the B-roll and the interviews into a 2 to 4 minute video with selected music designed to powerfully and effectively connect with our audience to be deployed on the Amelia County website, social media, events, and other platforms. The photography will be utilized in this manner as well. The video and photography finished products are designed to showcase the beauty, opportunities, and potential of Amelia County, Virginia, attracting both businesses and tourists to contribute to its growth and prosperity.
