

DOG OWNERSHIP IN ARLINGTON HEIGHTS



VILLAGE ANIMAL ORDINANCES

- An animal license is required, which can be purchased yearly at Village Hall. Village license tag and rabies tag must be affixed to your dog's collar.
- Dogs must be leashed when in public and are prohibited from parks. Remove and properly dispose of all dog waste.
- Pet ownership is limited to four animals per household.
- Stay mindful of outside temperatures when confining your dog to a motor vehicle.
- Be a good neighbor—avoid excessive or untimely barking.

LOST DOG?

In the event of a lost dog, notify the police information desk **immediately** at (847) 368-5300.

Keep the contact information on your dog's microchip up-to-date. This will avoid your pet being impounded if found at-large.



WHAT IF AN INCIDENT OCCURS?

All dog bites to humans and other animals must be reported to the Arlington Heights Police Department.

Bite incidents are forwarded to Cook County Animal Control. Documentation of all incidents, small or large, is essential for public safety.
