INFO, DETAILS & APPLICATION – Memorial Day Parade 2024

1. Marching unit leaders are responsible for communicating DETAILS on the parade and ceremony to all the people in their units.
2. There is **NO CHARGE** for your entry in the parade.
3. Your **Parade Position** number will be **emailed by May 24th** along with detailed instructions. Please make sure the e-mail address and cell phone number on your application are correct.
4. Your parade position number will be painted on the street in the Assembly Area by May 25. Check it out BEFORE the parade to determine the best way for your people to enter the very busy Assembly Area.
5. Parade assembly area starts at Village Hall and flows East along Davis Street. See page 2 of application.
6. The parade route is 1.25 miles (see map) and finishes at Memorial Park. The Assembly Area stretches nearly 1 mile East of Arl Hts Road
7. On May 27th, assemble your unit at your assigned parade position **no later than 9:00 am**. Earlier is better.
8. **The parade steps off at 9:30 am SHARP!**
9. Porta potties and water will be available in the assembly area before the parade starts and at Memorial Park at the parade endpoint.
10. Everyone is invited and encouraged to attend the Memorial Day Ceremony at Memorial Park. The ceremony starts at 11:00 am.

WEATHER

We will march if there is just a light rain or drizzle. If there is lightning, thunder, medium rain or heavy rain, we will cancel the parade and move the Memorial Day Ceremony inside. Watch for an announcement. **Just in case, unit leaders MUST monitor your email and text messages on May 24th, 25th, 26th and 27th.**

A SPECIAL REQUEST TO EVERYONE

We would like everyone to consider doing something to thank our veterans and active duty military. Here are just a few ideas...

1. Print out BOTH SIDES of the Arlington Remembers sign (attached). Place this sign in the windows of your home, business, school or organization. Read the names of Arlington's Fallen Heroes on the backside.
2. At the parade, wave the Arlington Remembers sign as our active military and veterans pass by.
3. If you are marching in the parade, please consider carrying signs, flags, banners, etc that say "Thank you veterans!"
4. If you are watching the parade along the route, please stand up, clap and say "Thank You" to our veterans and active duty military as they march by. For our Vietnam Veterans, say "Welcome Home".
5. Along the parade route, consider decorating buildings with banners, signs, flags, bunting – whatever is possible.
6. Or come up with your own creative way of saying "Thank You" for the service and sacrifice of our veterans and active duty military.

PARADE INSTRUCTIONS

Memorial Day Parade in Arlington Heights, IL

Monday, May 27, 2024

Assemble in your position NLT 9:00 am. Step Off: 9:30 am sharp

Parade Position Numbers will be painted on the street, near the center line, by May 25, 2024.



IN THE ASSEMBLY AREA: Your unit should begin assembling by 9:00 am. Step off is at 9:30 am SHARP. Sigwalt and Davis Streets will be restricted to **ONE WAY traffic going West**. Consider approaching from Arthur Ave on the East end of the Assembly Area.

PORTA POTTIES & WATER: A full rest station will be located at the corner of Bristol Lane and Davis St. The Rotary Club of Arlington Heights will provide lots of water bottles for participants.

PARKING: Parking is limited around the assembly area. Strongly consider car pooling, dropping off at the assembly area, and then parking near the end of the parade.

Parking is free on Memorial Day in all Village of Arl Hts garages and surface lots. Also, parking has been graciously offered by the Arlington Hts Memorial Library, the Christian Liberty Academy (East lot), and the Village Bank & Trust (on Rt 14). Street parking is limited.

DURING THE PARADE: With ~3,000 people marching, it is **CRUCIAL** that you keep your unit moving. Candy, flyers, etc., must be **handed** to parade viewers. **Do not throw**.

AT THE END OF THE PARADE: When you reach Memorial Park, **please move out of the way quickly**. Turn East onto St James St, proceed South to Northwest Highway, pickup at the Village Bank parking lot, or move into Memorial Park for the Ceremony (starts at 11:00 am). **The remainder of the parade will be behind you, and they need to keep moving.**

ABOUT THE WEATHER: Parade will proceed unless there is thunder or heavy rain. You are free to march or not. **If you need to take shelter at any time, please use parking garages noted on the Parade Route Map.**

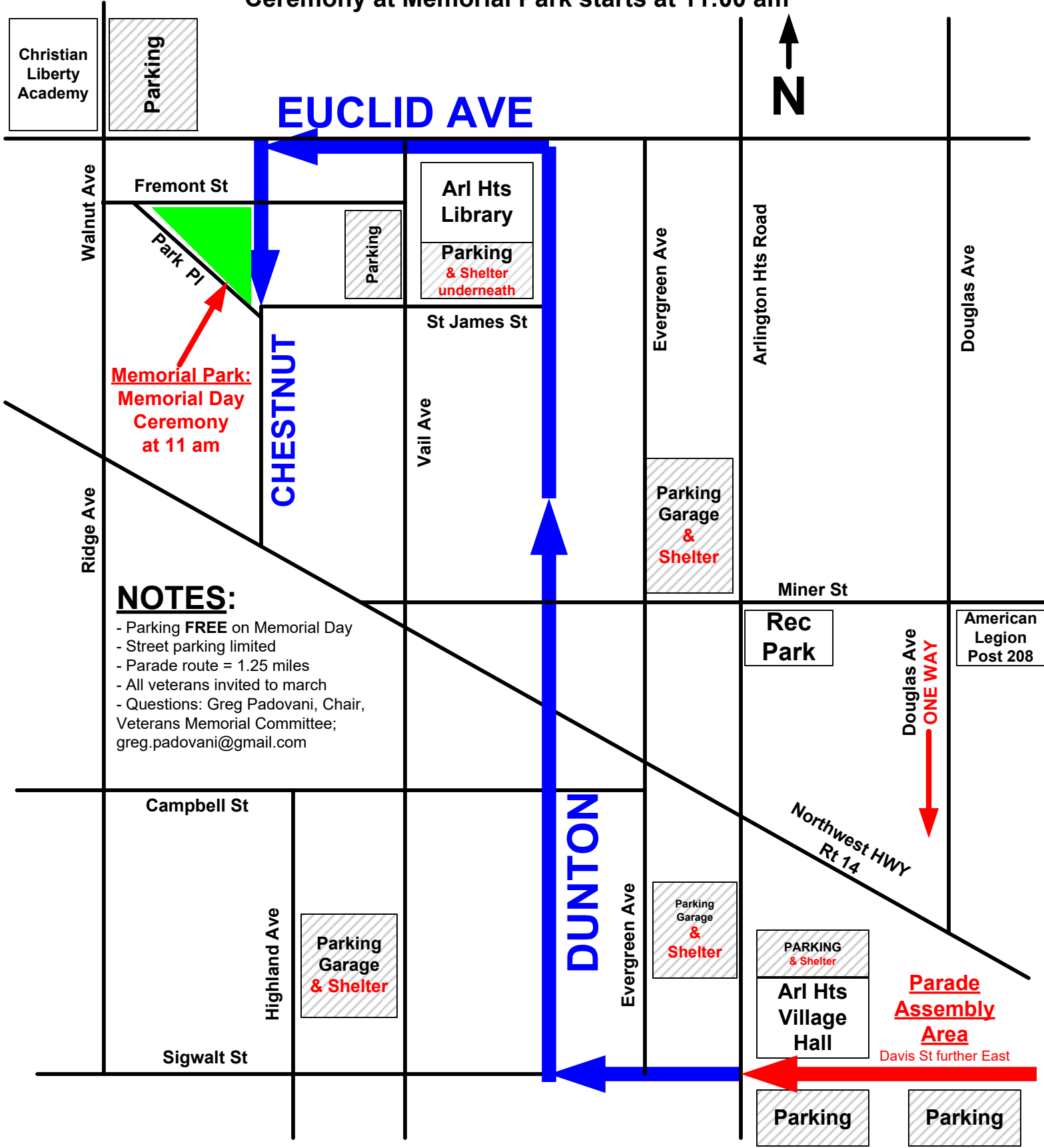
