Section 12-1701 Definition. "Itinerant dealer," when used in this Article, shall mean any person engaged in the business of buying or selling tangible objects within the Village who has not established a permanent place of business within the Village from which such operation has been carried on for a period of at least 90 days prior to the first sale or purchase of such objects. Any person who wishes to buy or sell such objects from a permanent place of business shall not be subject to the provisions of this ordinance upon a presentation to the Village Manager of a bona fide lease for a period of at least one year for permanent premises within the Village.

Section 12-1705 Records. Every itinerant dealer doing business in the Village shall keep a record of every article received, purchased, sold or exchanged setting forth the following: the date of the transaction, name and address of the purchaser or seller, and a brief description of the article sold, purchased, received or exchanged, including identification number thereon, if any. Such record and the articles themselves shall, at all reasonable times, be open to the inspection of any police officer.

Section 12-1706 Stolen Goods. It shall be the duty of every person licensed under the provisions of this Article to report to the police any article received or offered which that person has reason to believe was stolen or lost.
