SCHOOL PROFILE 2022-2023

Cony High School is located in the Capitol city of Augusta, Maine, an urban residential community of 19,000 people located in the central part of the state

Accredited by the Maine Department of Education

Offers a comprehensive program if studies for approximately 1000 students in grades 7-12

Operates on a 4X4 block schedule: 4 daily 75 minute blocks, separated into 2 semesters, which meet daily. AP Chemistry and AP Biology meet daily, extending into 2 semesters earning 1.5 credits. All other AP course extend into 2 semesters and meet every other day, earning 1 credit each.
