This summer, all kids 18 and under eat free starting July 10th and ending August 11th. The lunches will be provided Monday through Friday at the following locations and times:

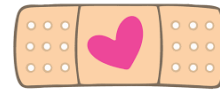
- Glenridge Apartments: 10:30-10:50**

School Medications

The end of the school year is coming upon us quickly.
Please pick up all inhalers, prescription medications, Epi-pens, and over the counter medications by June 14th.
All medications will be disposed of properly on June 14th if not picked up.

Field Day Sunscreen

Students may possess and **self-administer** topical sunscreen provided by the parent/guardian. Sunscreen is to be in its **original container, labeled with directions of use and warnings. Written permission from parent** is required. School nurse or other school personnel may inspect sunscreen product for safety and proper FDA labeling. **No aerosol or spray sunscreen allowed.**

7th Grade Immunization Requirements

Students who are moving on to 7th grade do require the following immunizations:

- Tdap (1 Dose)
- Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine (1 Dose)
