

Parents who will be registering a child for Pre-K for the 2023/2024 school year, will need to contact Gilbert School at 626-2491. To enroll in Pre-K, your child must live in Augusta and have turned four years old by 10/15/23. For parents who will be registering a kindergarten student for the 2023/2024 school year, please call Lincoln School at 626-2483. To enroll in Kindergarten, your child must be live in the Lincoln Attendance district and have turned five years old by 10/15/23. Ms. Cheever or Mrs. Cloutier, our school secretaries, will take your name and contact information down to send out registration information in early spring.
