

**TOWN OF BARGERSVILLE
ORDINANCE 2022-13**

**AN ORDINANCE REVISING RATES AND CHARGES
FOR THE USE OF AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE MUNICIPAL
ELECTRIC UTILITY OF THE TOWN OF BARGERSVILLE, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Town of Bargersville, Indiana ("Town") owns and operates a municipal electric utility in accordance with the provisions of Indiana Code 8-1.5, and acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, furnishing electrical energy in the Town and surrounding area; and

WHEREAS, the Town has caused a rate study dated May 31, 2022 on electric rates and charges of the Town's electric utility ("Rate Study") to be made by Baker Tilly Municipal Advisors, LLC, Indianapolis, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town ("Town Council") has previously established the rates and charges of the municipal electric utility of the Town pursuant to Ordinance No. 2021-____ (the "Rate Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Rate Study indicates that the current electric rates and charges established pursuant to the Rate Ordinance are not sufficient to produce income sufficient to maintain the utility property in a sound physical and financial condition to render adequate and efficient service and that the rates and charges should be increased; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town ("Town Council") withdrew from the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission ("Commission") on July 24, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has determined, based upon the Rate Study, that said proposed rates and charges are fair and necessary to provide for the continued operation of the electric utility; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BARGERSVILLE, INDIANA:

Section 1. The following revised rates and charges shall apply for the use of and the services rendered by the electric utility of the Town of Bargersville:

See Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. When future changes occur in the cost of purchased power, which changes would cause a change in said Purchased Power Cost Adjustment Tracking Factor calculated in accordance with the order of the Public Service Commission of Indiana approved on May 2, 1984, in Cause No. 36825-S2, as may be hereafter amended by the Commission, such factor shall automatically be changed accordingly and the superintendent of the electric utility of the Town shall cause the appropriate documents for approval of such change to be filed with the Commission.

Section 3. The Town Council hereby elects to receive payments in lieu of property taxes.

Section 4. The Town Council hereby elects to earn a reasonable return on the electric utility plant.


Section 5. All parts of Ordinances establishing recurring rates and charges inconsistent on Exhibit A attached herewith are repealed, such repeal being effective as of the effective date of this Ordinance.


Section 6. All rates and charges not amended herein shall not be repealed or changed as a result of this Ordinance. In particular, all non-recurring charges established by Bargersville Ordinances shall not be repealed or changed.


Section 7. This Ordinance and the rates and charges set forth herein shall be effective as provided in Exhibit A attached hereto.
