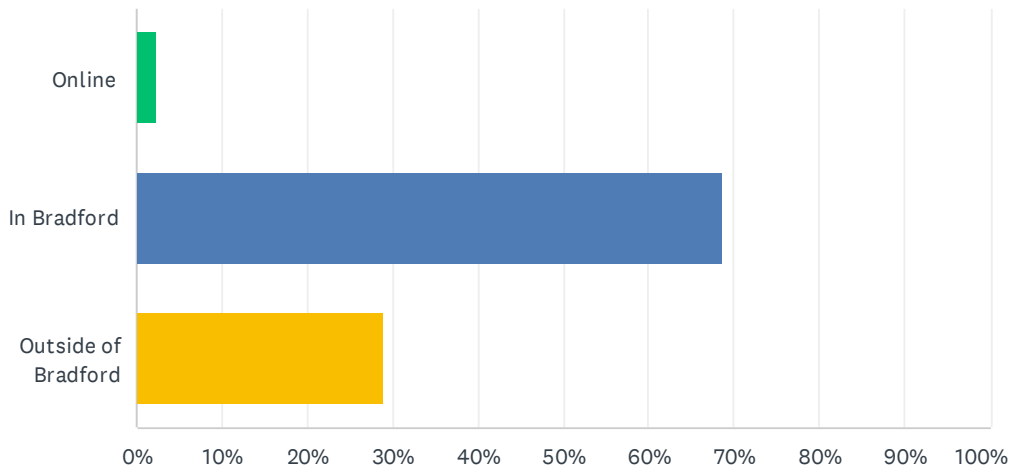


Q1 Where do you do the majority of your weekly shopping"

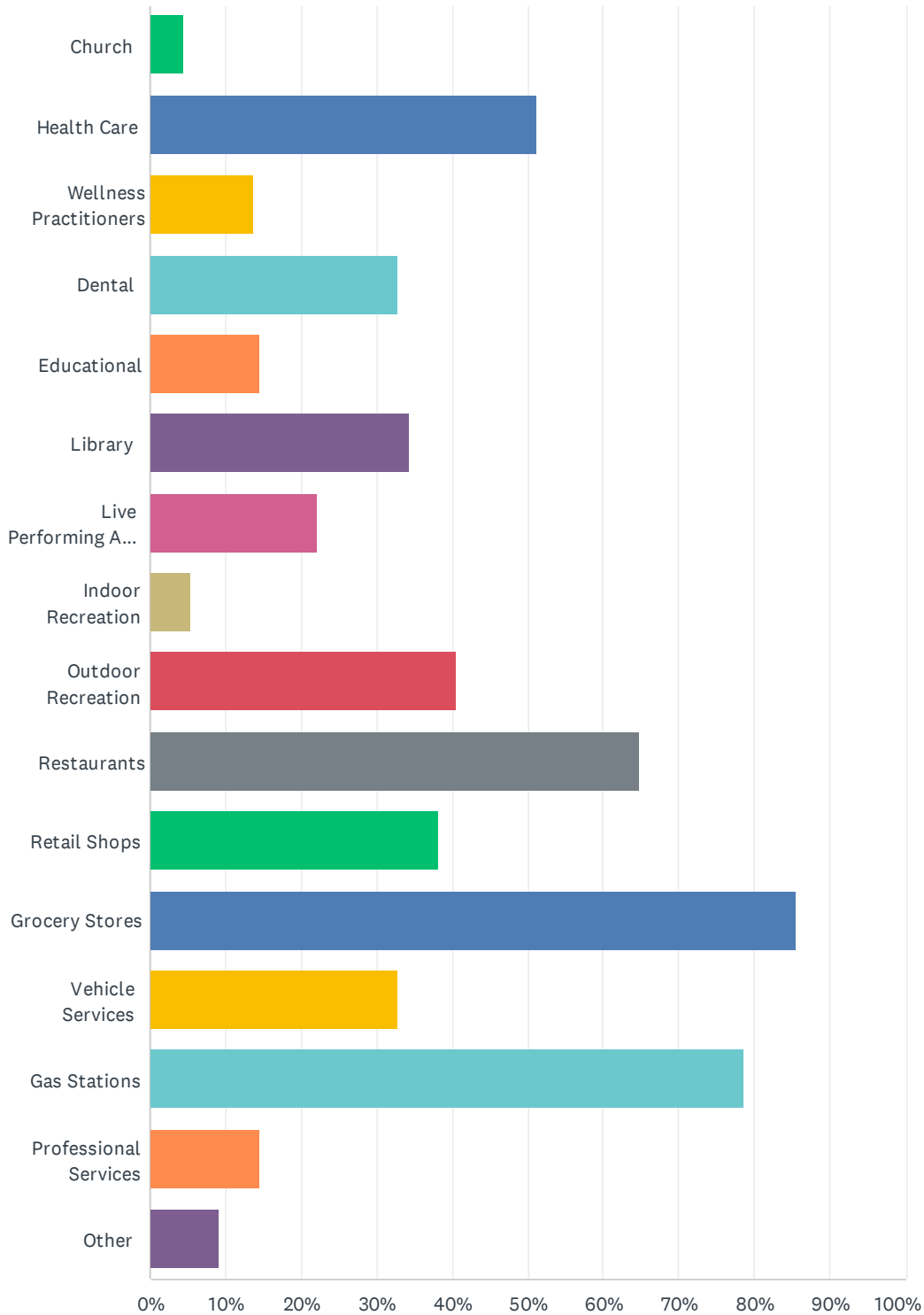

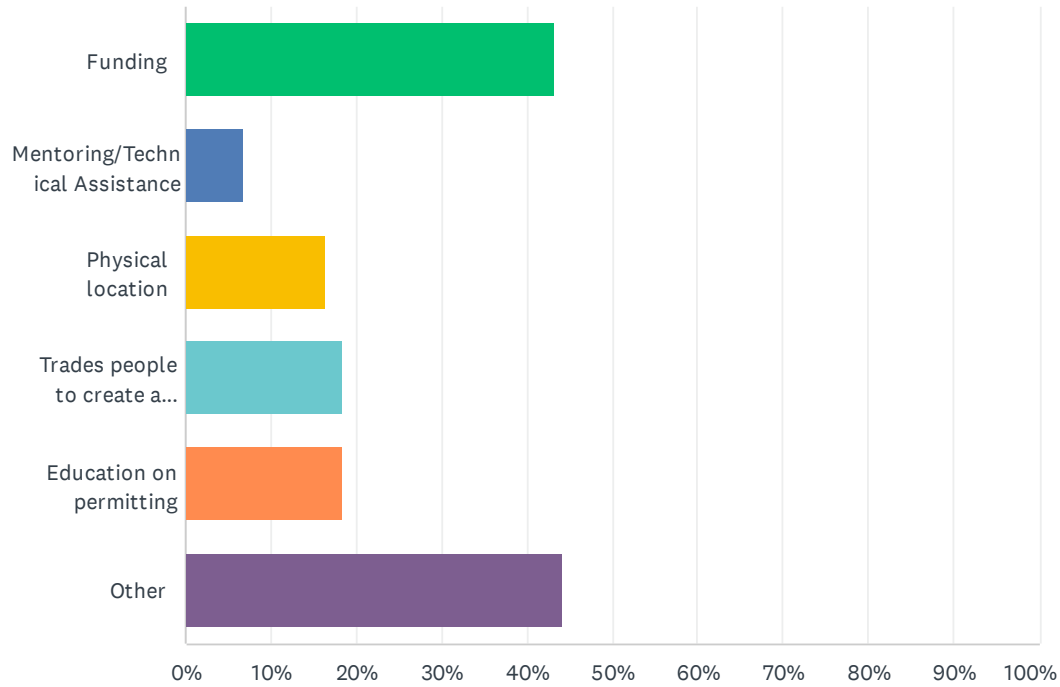

Q31 In the past year, how often have you attended Selectboard meetings?

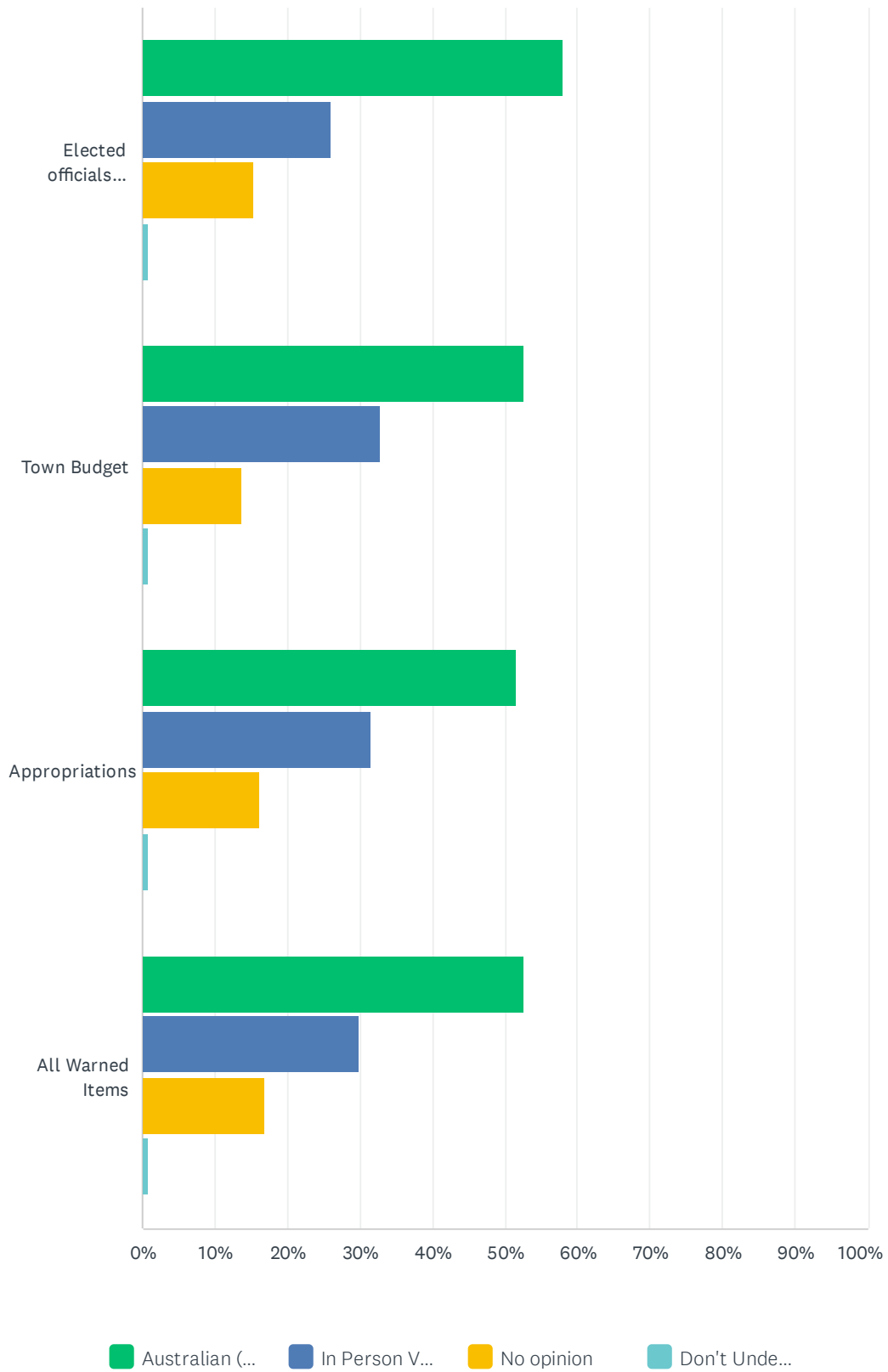

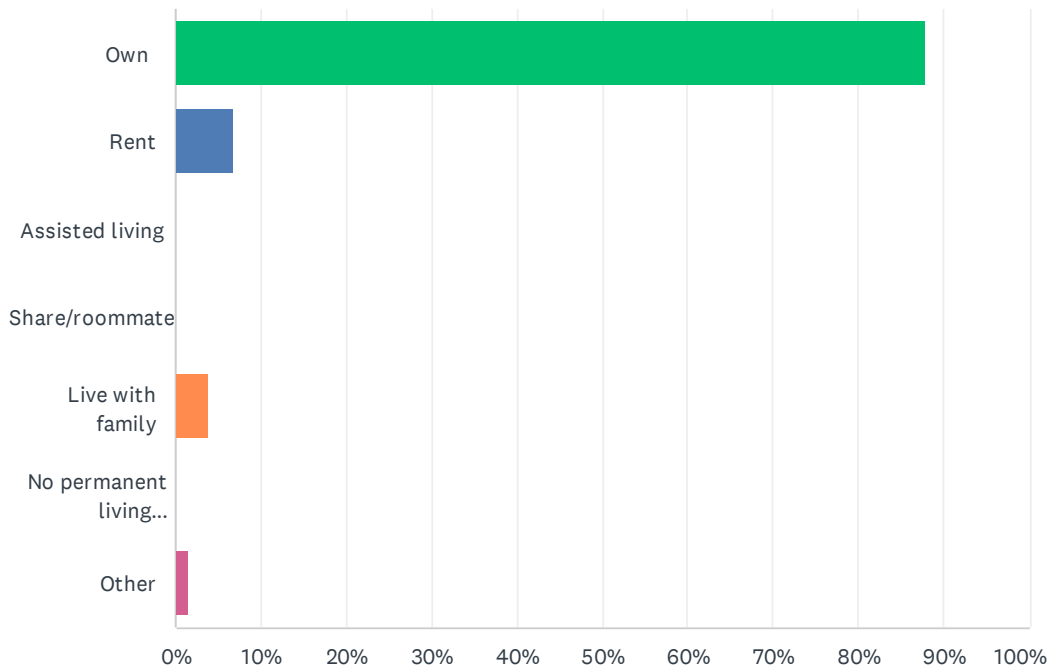

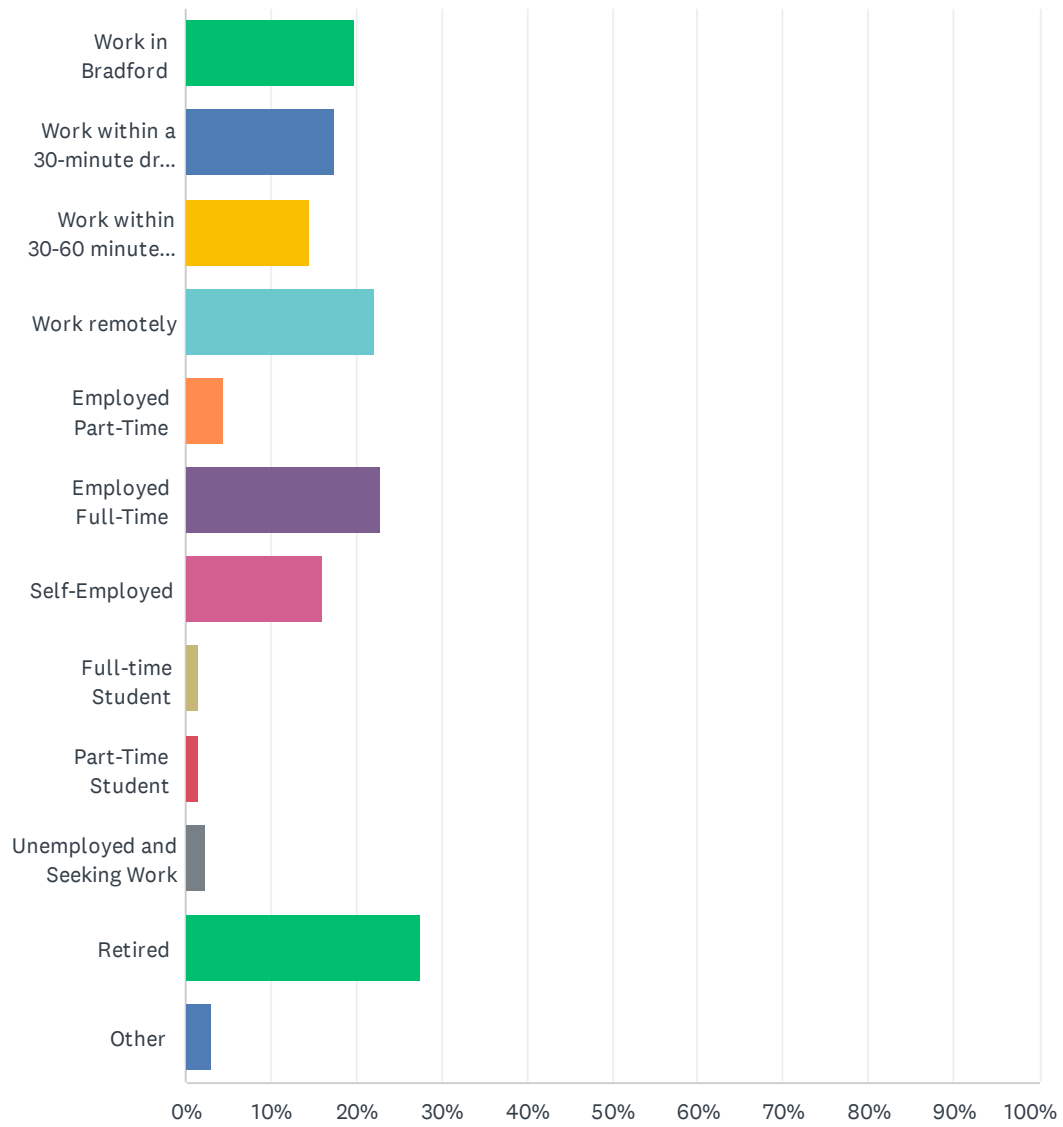

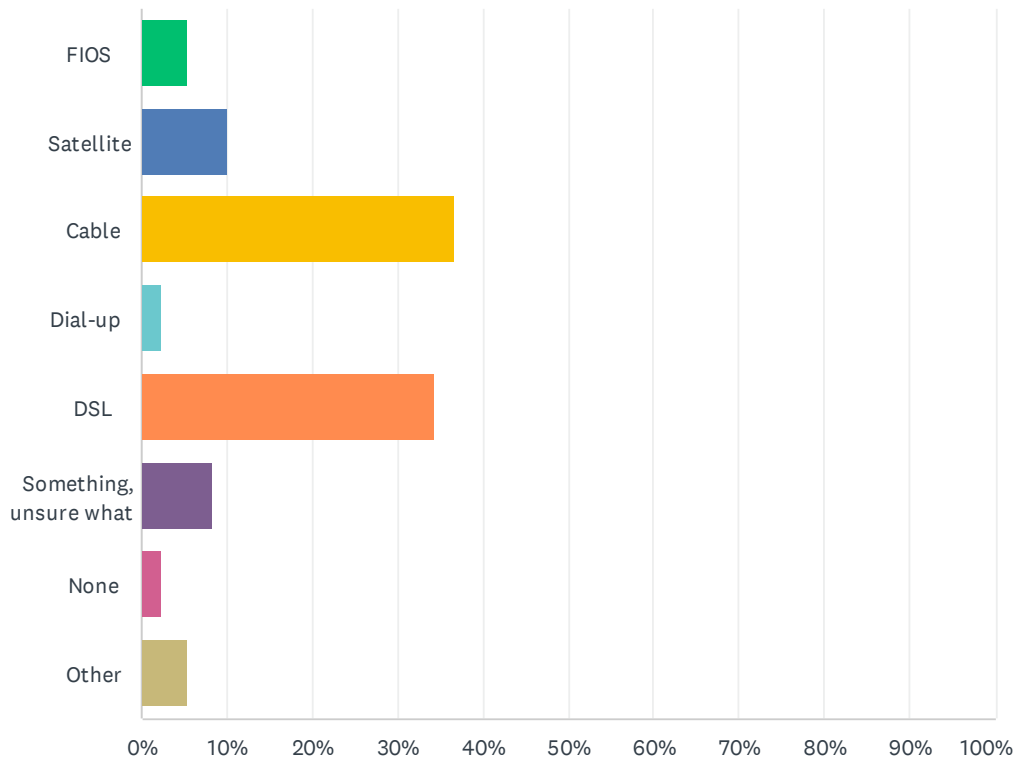

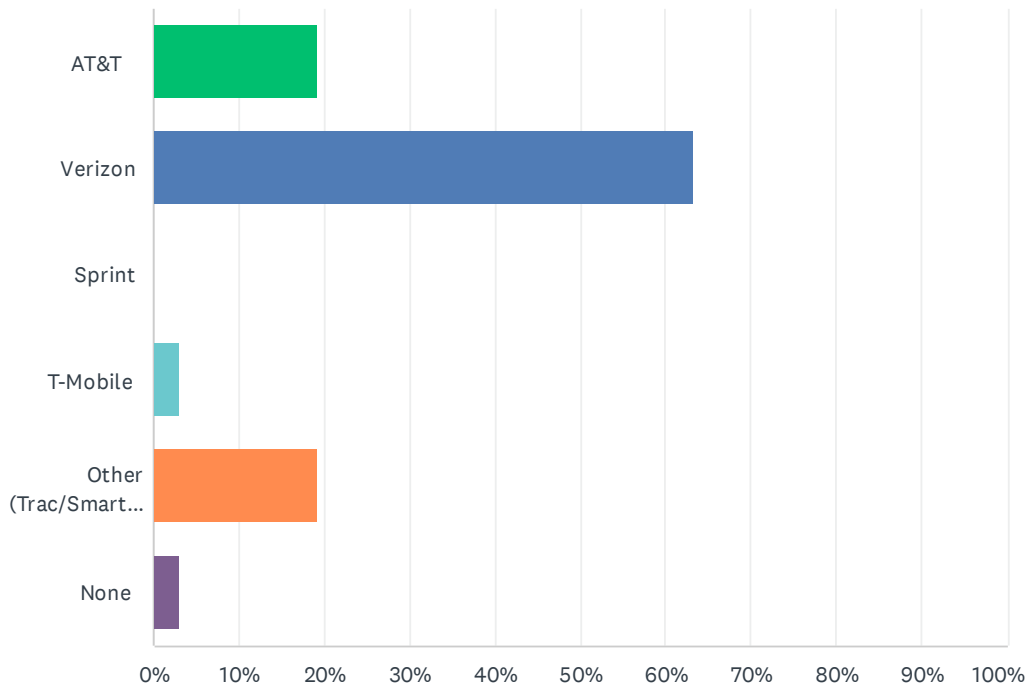
