

PAINTED CORK COASTER

MATERIALS:

- 4 CORK COASTERS
- FOAM PAINTBRUSH
- 3 PAINT COLORS
- 4 FELT CIRCLES
- TAPE (DIFFERENT WIDTHS)
- MOD PODGE
- GLUE DOTS

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Tape off sections on your coaster to make a pattern. make sure the tape is pressed down well and has no bubbles or gaps where the paint could seep through. The spaces you leave open are where the paint will go and the taped down parts will be unpainted cork.
2. Paint the sections. To get the best coverage, bounce your foam paintbrush so that you're dabbing the paint on rather than brushing. be sure to paint within the spaces so that one color doesn't mix into another section. You may need to do two coats depending on the color. Let dry between coats.
3. Once completely dry, peel off the tape.
4. Paint on the Mod Podge to seal the acrylic on the coaster. Paint even strokes.
5. Once the Mod Podge is dry, use the glue dots to affix the felt to the bottom of the coaster,
