Fall Leaf Banner

MATERIALS:

- 2 sheets of leaf templates
- Colored paper
- 6 book pages (extra, just in case)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Cut out the leaf templates of each size.
- 2. Trace the small leaves on the book pages and cut them out.
- 3. Trace the large leaves on the colored paper and cut them out.
- 4. Using the glue dots, affix the book page leaves in the middle of the colored paper leaves.
- 5. Clip the leaves onto the string using the clothespins, making sure the leaves are spaced evenly apart.
- 6. Hang wherever you wish and get into the fall spirit!
