

Map Stationery

MATERIALS

- Envelope template
- Notecard template
- Map
- 4.5" x 6.5" paper (for folded card)
- Circle die cut
- Circle phrases
- Notecard paper (will be smaller than the folded card paper)
- Rectangle paper for address labels
- Scissors (not included)
- Glue stick (not included)

INSTRUCTIONS

- Start by cutting out your envelope template and tracing it onto your map.
- Cut out the traced envelope and fold the two pointed sides in.
- Place glue on the bottom edges of the pointed sides, and fold the bottom curved side up. Ta-da! You have an envelope!
- To make the card, fold your 4.6x6.5" rectangle in half. Either decorate this card yourself or glue the circle die-cut on the front. You can either write your own phrase on the die cut or cut out one of the pre-printed circle phrases and glue in the center of the die cut.
- To make the notecard, cut out the template, trace it onto your paper, and cut it out.
- If you'll be mailing these, affix the address labels with the smaller one in the upper left corner and the larger one in the center.
- Feel free to use these templates again and again with maps, book pages, magazines, etc.
