

## Materials provided:

- 8 paper bags
- 1 glue stick
- Twine

## Materials not provided:

Scissors

## Instructions

- 1. Glue 4 bags on top of one another. Apply the glue in a 'T' shape, down the middle and along the bottom 'closed' end, leaving the 'open' end without glue.
- 2. Because it is difficult to cut all 8 bags at once, pause the gluing process after the first 4 bags to cut off the open corners. You will be cutting the others later. Don't worry if your cuts are uneven- they'll still look great!
- 3. Glue the other 4 bags on top of the ones you've already done and then cut off the open corners on those, as well, matching the cuts you already made on the first 4.
- 4. Let the glue dry a bit and then place a 'T' of glue on one side of your stack of bags.
- 5. Fan open your bags and glue the two ends together to form the circular star shape.
- 6. Poke a hole through one of the points on the star and thread the twine through if you wish to hang your star!
