

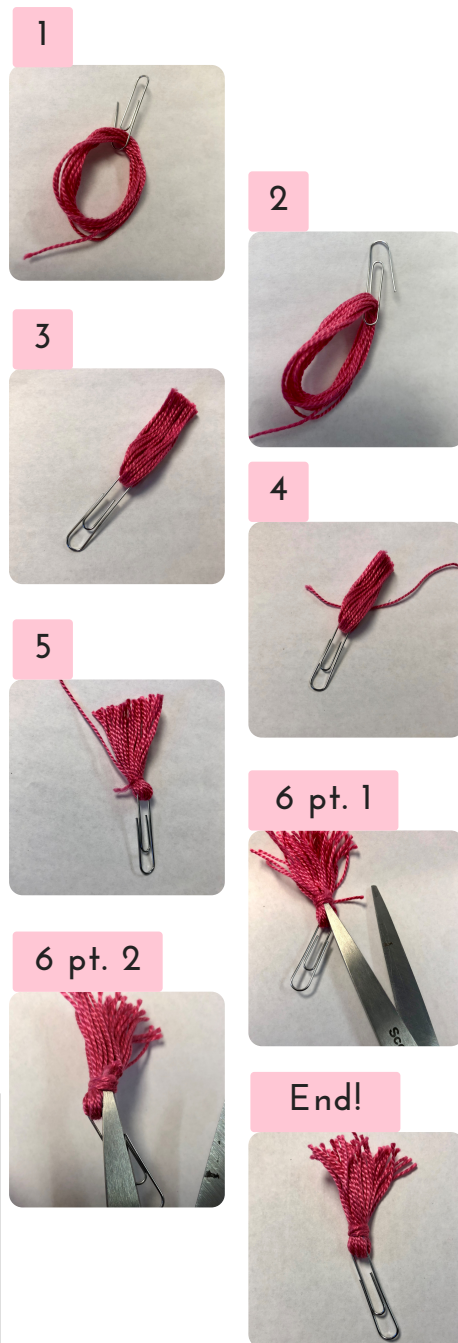
TASSEL PAPER CLIP BOOKMARKS

MATERIALS

- 3 paper clips
 - 3 loops of embroidery thread
 - 3 single strings of embroidery thread.
- Not included:
- Scissors

INSTRUCTIONS

1. First open your paper clip and thread it though the loop in your embroidery floss, then close the paper clip.
2. Move the loop to the closed end of the paper clip. Close the paper clip so that it's back to it's regular shape.
3. Cut off the end of the floss to the length that you want your tassel.
4. Place the single string under the tassel.
5. Tie in a knot towards the top of the tassel. Make this fairly tight.
6. Wrap around the remaining end tightly then, using your scissors, tuck in the end of the wrapped string under the wrap. (be sure not to cut any of the floss while doing so).
7. Repeat all of these steps for your other 2 paper clips
