# New Resource

We have big news! Your library card now gives you access to Hoopla, a service that provides online access to e-books, e-audiobooks, music, movies, TV shows, and comics. The Library pays individually for each checkout, so you get 7 checkouts per month per library card. With this checkout method, there are no hold lines for materials – you get immediate access!

To access Hoopla, you can download the Hoopla app on your phone, tablet, or streaming device, or visit <a href="https://www.hoopladigital.com">www.hoopladigital.com</a>. To create an account, you'll search for the Brookings Public Library, then enter your library card number and the first 8 characters of your last name in lowercase letters as your PIN. From then on, you'll log in using your email address and the password you create.
