NEW AND NOTABLE

The year is almost over! Can you believe it? 2022 has great things in store! Keep an eye out in the newsletter for dates for Adult Game Nights, Drop-In Tech Help, and Escape Rooms. Storytime, Music Makers, kids activities, and exciting teen events will all be back, too! We are so excited to announce that the Library received two major grants in October. The Dollar General Literacy Foundation awarded the Library \$2500. These funds were used to purchase Wonderbooks, a print book with a preloaded audio player attached, and Launchpads, tablets designed for kids ages 3-10, containing pre-loaded education games. We also received a \$3000 grant from the American Library Association to participate in Libraries Transforming Communities: Focus on Small and Rural Libraries, an initiative that helps library workers better serve their small and rural communities. This money will go towards Black History Month events and a community conversation in February 2022! Details for these events will be coming soon
