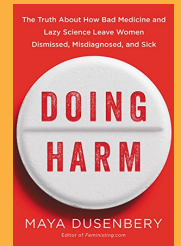

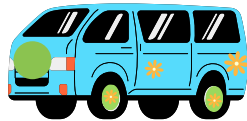
Scooby Doo Escape Room (RR)

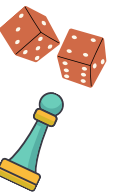

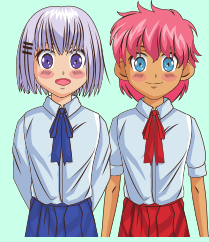
