# Start of Official Canvass for the May 4, 2010 Primary Election

May 17, 2010, 9:00 a.m.

At 9:07 a.m. Tim Rudd called the meeting to order. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane, Rick Combs and Paul Campbell. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

**OTHER ATTENDEES:** Nick Sommer – ISD, Michael Collins and Shekar Jayaraman – Field Liaison arrived at 9:36 a.m.

#### **TEST DECK:**

Rick Combs and Dave Lane observed Nick Sommer run the Test Deck through the 650 scanner. Tim read the results of the Test Deck as Dave compared them to the previous results. The Board found the results to match.

2010-56 – Paul Campbell made the motion to Accept the Results of the Test Deck. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

#### ABSENTEE BALLOTS:

Director Miller explained a situation with regard to the Absentee Ballots. When the absentee ballots were being opened on Election Day prior to being scanned through the 650 reader, a clerk discovered when opening an ID Envelope that it contained 2 sets of voted ballots from 2 different precincts. The clerk alerted Judy and Mike of the situation. The clerk later found an Absentee Envelope that did not contain any Absentee Ballot; this was also brought to Judy and Mike's attention. Judy contacted the Secretary of State's Office and Mary Lynne Birck of the situation. Mary Lynne said she would have a written report for the Board at the opening of canvass. She submitted a letter of correspondence for the Board to review. (This legal correspondence for the Board from their Legal Counsel was not considered a public record.) Judy advised the Board that per O.R.C. 3509.07, regarding two sets of ballots in one envelope, those ballots should both be rejected.

2010-57 – Rick Combs made the motion to not count the two (2) sets of Absentee Ballots contained in the one (1) Absentee ID Envelope per Ohio Revised Code 3509.07. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

**2010-58** – Rick Combs made the motion to refer the Absentee Ballot Envelope containing the two (2) sets of absentee ballots and the Empty Absentee Ballot Envelope to the Prosecutor's Office. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

The total number of Republican absentee ballots with rotation problems was 716. There were 502 second/replacement ballots returned after the voters had returned the first ballot (these were counted election night). There were 110 second ballots returned without returning the first ballot (these have not been counted yet).

There were 84 ballots that require duplication – these were the first ballots that were returned and the second/replacement ballot was not returned. One (1) Democrat absentee ballot needs to be counted; it was mistakenly put with the Republican ballots. There was one (1) in-office absentee voter that did not complete the party change form (10-Z). The voter did come in and complete the form within the 10 day period.

There are a total of 86 absentee ballots to be added to the count. (Section C)

## **INVALID ABSENTEE BALLOTS:**

There were 96 requested absentee ballots that were not voted or invalid for various reasons. (Section D)

44 – refused by nursing home voters

3 – returned with no secrecy envelope

3 – did not include date of birth

2 – did not include identification

1 - did not include date of birth or identification

1 – identification envelope blank

1 – ballot returned undeliverable

2 - no party change forms (10-Z)

25 – postmarked day of election or later

12 – received after election day with no postmark

2 – absentees left at the polls on election day (UN-P)

The staff tried to contact the voters to complete the missing information.

**2010-59** – Dave Lane made the motion to reject and not count the 96 absentee ballots that the staff has identified as being invalid under section D of the agenda. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

## **VALID ABSENTEE BALLOTS:**

There were 15 valid absentee ballots that should be added to the count. (Section E)

- 10 postmarked before election day and received within the 10 day period
- 3 Republican replacement ballot (pre-paid post mark by the Board)
- 2 damaged by Postal Service requires duplication

**2010-60** – Dave Lane made the motion to accept and count the additional absentee ballots that the staff has declared valid, as identified in Sections C and E, making any necessary duplications, and add them to the count. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

#### PROVISIONAL BALLOTS:

Director Miller explained the Provisional Ballots. See Attachement. There were 137 provisional ballots cast, 130 were valid and 7 were invalid.

## "INVALID PROVISIONAL BALLOTS:

The 7 invalid Provisionals included: (5) - 17 Year Olds that were not registered, 1-voted in the wrong precinct and 1 had no ID shown or listed.

The voter that voted in the wrong precinct was the result of a poll worker error. The street was East Glen Echo (MI-F1F) and was the poll worker looked up Glen Echo (MI-H1H). Tim thinks this voter's ballot should be duplicated; they provided required identification and only voted in the wrong precinct because of our poll workers error. Judy stated there were no provisions for this situation; there is a Directive that deals with "homeless voters". The Code states that if the voter votes in the wrong precinct we can not count their vote. Tim stated that the Code does provide that the Board can determine voter intent and feels this is a situation where the Board should allow this ballot to be duplicated and counted. Tim understands the situation when a voter will not go to their correct polling location and insists on voting at the incorrect location and then in that situation the ballot should not be duplicated.

2010-61 – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the provisional ballot that was voted in the wrong precinct based upon the error of the poll worker and that we duplicate from MI-H1H to MI-F1F and add it to the provisional count. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon discussion Paul asked Judy what the ramification is to accepting the ballot. The previous advice from the Secretary of State's Office has been that if it is a poll worker error unfortunately that vote can not be counted. There will be provisions in the new law to correct that problem. Rick added that the Board is to determine voter intent, so that is a conflict between two existing sections and feels we should not be criticized. Upon roll call, Rick Combs-"yes", Paul Campbell-"yes", Dave Lane-"no", Tim Rudd-"yes".

2010-62 – Paul Campbell made the motion to reject the 6 remaining provisional ballots that the staff has determined to be invalid. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

### **VALID PROVISIONAL BALLOTS:**

**2010-63** – Dave Lane made the motion to accept the 130 valid provisional ballots that the staff has determined to be valid. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

**2010-64** – Rick Combs made the motion to instruct the office staff to proceed with the Official Canvass. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

### **BILLS:**

2010-65 – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the bills as of May 17, 2010. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon discussion Rick inquired about using the tent on Election Day. Mike stated that there is a penalty clause if you cancel within 10 days and we can not predict the weather that day. Rick also appreciates the two advertising costs staying reasonably close. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

The Board will stay in Session, stands in Recess and will Reconvene Tuesday, May 25, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.

## Certification of Primary Election May 25, 2010, 10:00 a.m.

Tim Rudd called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane, Rick Combs and Paul Campbell. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

**OTHER ATTENDEES:** Jackie Smith – Clerk running the Test Deck, Shekar Jayaraman – Field Liaison, and Michael Collins.

### **TEST DECK AND CERTIFICATION:**

Dave and Rick observed Jackie Smith run the Test Deck through the 650 scanner. Tim read the previous report as Dave checked it with the newly run Final Test Deck. The Board found the results to match.

**2010-66** – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept the results of the Test Deck. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

**2010-67** – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept the Election Results and Certify the May 4, 2010 Primary Election. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

Director Miller gave the Board copies of the overlapping candidates. She also stated that there were no races that qualified for an automatic recount. The Write-In races were thoroughly checked. There were 3 races in which the Write-In Candidate did not receive any votes.

June 1, 2010 is the last day to request a recount. A deposit of \$55.00 is required.

The Board entered into the Regular Monthly Meeting of May 25, 2010.

## REGULAR BOARD MEETING May 25, 2010

## **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**2010-68** – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the minutes of the April 27, 2010 Board Meeting. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

#### APPROVAL OF BILLS:

**2010-69** – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the May bills. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

## **DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

Director Miller advised the Board that Robert Scott Croswell III filed petitions as an Independent Candidate for County Commissioner. The required amount of signatures was 651 and he filed 1,571 signatures (the signatures can be from any party). The Board will Certify the petitions at the June Board Meeting. Rick inquired about the party status indication on the ballot for an Independent voter. Judy stated per the code, the candidate chooses at the time of filing to either have "no designated party" under their name or leave it blank. Mr. Croswell chose to not have any designation; it will be blank under his name.

No entities filed for an August Special Election. The Commissioner's are aware that there will be no Special Election.

## REFERRAL TO PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE CONCERNING ABSENTEE BALLOT ENVELOPE:

The situation regarding 2 different Absentee Ballots returned in 1 envelope was referred to the Prosecutor's Office. Woody Breyer (Prosecutor's Office) sent a letter for only the Board Members to read.

2010-70 – Dave Lane made the motion to maintain the Absentee Ballots referred back to us from the Prosecutor's Office with the remaining Absentee Ballots from the election. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

Judy reported on the DIMS Contract. The "Fee Schedule" has been removed from the contract. The Board is still questioning what will happen if our voter registration goes over 150,000 in the next five years, as to what the increased cost would be. Rick noticed the date on the back page is 2009 instead of 2010. Dave suggested sending the contract to our Legal Counsel to review. She gave the Board correspondence regarding the Vote Remote.

The DIMS-NeT user Conference is June 24, 2010 in Lancaster. This is the day after the SOS Summer Conference in Columbus. Judy doesn't think it is necessary to attend. She spoke with Tim Murawski and he stated there would be other forms of training (ie WebX) on the topics to be covered. Also the Re-Districting session is not something we need to attend at this time. He also mentioned he would have Robert Barnhouse come to our office to go over this information with us.

Robin Fields will be coming to our office on June 10, 2010 to discuss DXI.

Rick discussed training for Nick Sommer. Judy stated that Jerry Amick is working on that and Steve Rabolt has recommended training 3 ISD personnel (which would include Nick Sommer). Tim asked if Nick would benefit from the DIMS Conference. Judy advised that the WebX training will be more

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beneficial. Rick encourages Tim Rudd to work with Judy and the County Administrator to move forward with dialogue with any concerns this Board may have.

The SOS Summer Conference is June 21-23, 2010. Those attending are Dave Lane, Paul Campbell, Judy Miller, Mike Keeley, Bonnie Carlier, Terrie Latham, Jackie Smith and Becky Rudd.

Judy advised the Board that we received a letter from the Secretary of State commending our work on the SWVRD (Statewide Voter Registration Database). We are in the top five of the State on keeping our database up to date. Rick suggested putting the letter on the website.

Judy spoke with Mark Kelly about the cost of reprinting the Republican ballots. After reviewing the situation they are unable to give us a discount. (We had 5,5875 ballots to reprint at a cost of \$0.25 per ballot totaling \$13,968.75. We also had the additional cost of postage.

We trained 735 poll workers for this election, including the ADA training on the Automark. We were accepted for a grant for poll worker training and were reimbursed \$3,740.00. They allow \$5.00 per poll worker plus training material fees. We were also reimbursed \$733.00 for Poll Worker Training from 2009. This money goes into the General Fund but Judy will make the Commissioners aware that these are chargeback monies.

**2010-71** – Rick Combs made the motion to execute the In Person Poll Worker Training Grant Agreement. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all members voted "yes".

Rick asked, as of the Election Day, how many trained poll workers do we have in a utility file to use. Judy said we have about 800, but some poll workers only want to work certain elections. About 100 couldn't be contacted. When the checks were mailed Judy included a Thank You Letter and a response letter to let us know how the training was and if they would be working in November. Rick asked if we needed more poll workers and Judy stated we did. Rick suggested using people that worked for the Census. They discussed different ideas to attract poll workers. They suggested purchasing a list and decide what type of people to target. They also suggested automated phone calls.

### **DEPUTY DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

Deputy Director Keeley highly praised the new deployment company, Commercial Works. They were very professional. He would like to stay with them for future elections.

Mike reported that we will need to move Precincts SK-A (431), SK-B (603) and SK-C (668 voters) out of the CNE Primary School, 463 S. Broadway St., Owensville. The building is for sale and we will need a new location for the November Election. Mike is thinking of using the multi-purpose building at the Fairgrounds. Tim suggested looking into using the 4-H Building and inquiring about the rental costs of the buildings at the Fairgrounds. Rick suggested the new Firehouse on Rt. 50. We will be moving out of the Wildwood Full Gospel Church (SK-C, SK-D and SK-G). Mike is still looking into a new church in the area as a possible polling location.

Rick inquired about the traffic at the First Baptist Church of Glen Este on Election Day. Judy stated everything went fine. It was manned from 6:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and again at 3:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. Our cost was \$100. Rick said he would talk to them for the November Election.

We will be at the Summer Conference June 21-23.

Judy asked to reschedule the June Regular Board Meeting because of the conflict with the Summer Conference. The Board rescheduled the meeting for Monday June 28, 2010 at 10:00 a.m.

**RESOLUTIONS:** None.

**EXECUTIVE SESSION:** None.

June 28, 2010 at 10:00 a.m., Regular Monthly Board Meeting and Certification of Independent Candidates to the November Ballot. July 22, 2010 at 10:00 a.m., - Regular Monthly Board Meeting.
