

**Start of Official Canvass for the
November 8, 2011 General Election**

November 21, 2011

Chairman Tim Rudd called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane, Rick Combs, and Paul Campbell. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

OTHER ATTENDEES: None.

TEST DECK:

Director Miller provided the Board with the Test Deck. Dave and Rick observed Nick Sommer run the Test Deck thru the 650 scanner. Tim and Dave compared the results with the previous Test Deck and found the results to match.

2011-94 – Rick Combs made the motion to verify and accept the results of the Test Deck. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

2011-95 – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept the staff's recommendation to find 106 Absentee Ballots unacceptable and find 53 Absentee Ballots as valid and for them to be opened and added to the count. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

Director Miller explained to the Board that we had 1 Gap Voter vote in the office. This person registered and voted the same day.

2011-96 – Dave Lane made the motion to accept the Gap Voter and add it to the count. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

PROVISIONAL VOTERS:

Judy advised the Board that there were 1,071 Provisional Ballots.

2011-97 – Paul Campbell made the motion upon the staff's recommendation, to reject the 130 Invalid Provisional Ballots. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

PROVISIONAL BALLOTS TO BE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD

Judy explained that there were 3 provisional voters that did not sign their envelope and this should be reviewed for poll worker error. The Board did not see that there was any Poll Worker error. There was also 1 provisional voter that did not print their name on the envelope.

2011-98 – Dave Lane made the motion to reject the 4 Provisional Ballots; 3 voters that did not sign their envelope and 1 voter that did not print their name on the envelope. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

VALID PROVISIONAL BALLOTS

2011-99 – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the 2 Provisional Ballots that voted in the wrong precinct at the polls, but in the correct polling location and used their SS# as identification. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

2011-100 – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept the 935 Provisional Ballots designated by the staff to be Valid. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

The total number of Valid Provisional Ballots is 937.

The Board instructed the Office Staff to proceed with the Official Canvass per Board Policy in the Election Administration Plan.

The Chairman reminded the Board that the December Regular Board Meeting is rescheduled for December 19, 2011 at 2:00 p.m. and will include the Certification of Candidates & Issues for the March 6, 2012 Primary Election.

The Board will stay in Session but go into Recess and will Reconvene on Tuesday, November 29, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. to complete the Official Canvass and Certification of the General Election and to hold the Regular November Monthly Meeting.

Board Reconvenes
Certification and Regular Meeting
November 29, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.

The Board Reconvened on November 29, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane, Rick Combs and Paul Campbell. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

Rick Combs asked for a moment of silence in remembrance of Mr. Jim Bushman (Husband of County Auditor, Linda Fraley and Candidate who was just elected to Batavia Township Trustee who was killed in a tragic accident on Monday, November 21, 2011).

TEST DECK:

Rick Combs and Dave Lane observed Nick Sommer run the Test Deck thru the 650 scanner. Tim read the results from the previous Test Deck as Dave tallied them against the current Test Deck results and found them to match.

2011-101 – Dave Lane made the motion to accept the Results of the Test Deck. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

Judy provided the Board with the Certified Results.

CERTIFICATION OF THE NOVEMBER 8, 2011 GENERAL ELECTION:

2011-102 – Rick Combs made the motion to Certify the Results of the November 8, 2011 General Election and report them to the Secretary of State's Office. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

Director Miller reported to the Board that three races qualify for an Automatic Recount, Bethel Village Council, Neville Village Council, and West Clermont Board of Education Member. All three candidates in the Bethel Village Council race are write-in candidates and all will be recounted with two to be elected (Lucy Shepherd-145, Jeremiah S. Hembree-143, John G. Hutchinson-142). Neville Village Council had two to be elected and there was a declared winner, James McMath. The recount is for the second seat between Lena Fisher and Rob Gastrich and they are a tie vote with 16 votes each. The Board must declare a winner before the recount. There was a declared winner (Tammy Brinkman-8,405) in the West Clermont School Board race and the recount is for the second seat (Tina Sanborn-7,067, Jeffrey Kohls-6,984, and Daniel W. Krueger-5,742).

The Board set the date for the Opening of the Recount: Wednesday December 7, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. and Close and Certification of Recount: Friday December 9, 2011 at 2:00 p.m.

BREAKING OF TIE VOTE-NEVILLE VILLAGE COUNCIL:

The Board decided to break the tie for the Neville Village Council race between Lena Fisher and Rob Gastrich by a coin toss. Chairman Tim Rudd stated that Lena Fisher was "heads" and Rob Gastrich was "tails".

Tim tossed the coin and it landed "tails up." Mr. Gastrich was declared the winner of the Neville Village Council race. There will still be a recount in this race. (The Board prepared and signed a Certification of the "Winner of the Tie Vote" which will hang in the office for at least the next 5 days.)

The Board proceeded with the Regular Monthly Meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

2011-103 – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the Minutes from the October 27, 2011 Regular Board Meeting. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

2011-104 – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept and pay the November Bills. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon discussion Rick inquired that it appears more bills are being approved by the Director and Deputy Director. He understands there are emergency purchases and there are times that the bills must be approved and paid. He also stated that he feels the Board needs to approve and sign off on the purchases. There are more and more in pre-approve mode. If it is not in the Code for the Board to

approve the Bills than he is fine with making a motion for the Director and Deputy Director to take care of and have the responsibility for the bills. Paul does not see anything (in these bills) that is not directly necessary to putting on an election. Rick does not want to pay more for any bills that we could have paid less for. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

2011-105 – Paul Campbell made the motion to review the previous delegation and if necessary make adjustments. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Director Miller advised the Board of the upcoming OAEO Conference in Columbus January 25-27, 2011. If the agenda includes topics that could benefit the staff, Judy would like to send Edna Owens, Becky Rudd, Jackie Smith, and Terrie Latham. Judy, Mike, and Paul will attend. Dave will go for one day.

Judy went over the 2011 Appropriations and where we are short. We were short for poll worker payroll and additional appropriations made to keep up with the bills until the end of the year. We were short \$43,198 (because of the Munis problem) and the additional appropriation of \$43,500 was granted 11/21/2011. We have stayed within our budget and are in good shape. Judy does have concerns for next year because of 2 primaries and the cost of party and non partisan ballots. Chargebacks for the May 3, 2011 Election was \$81,619.80 and the estimated November 8, 2011 election is \$211,000.

Rick suggested moving forward with the staff evaluations and have them ready for the December Board Meeting.

Judy gave the Board a copy of the Offices for 2012 elections and their filing deadlines.



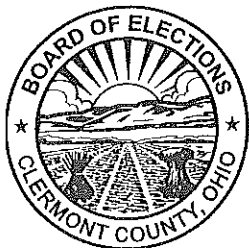



This is to certify that there was a Tie Vote in the Council Race in the Village of Neville, Ohio as follows:





The Board further declared that there will be a Recount in this race set to begin on Wednesday, December 7, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.


