

**Start of Official Canvass for the  
May 6, 2014 Primary Election**

\*\*\*\*\*

**May 19, 2014 at 9:00 a.m.**

Chairman Tim Rudd called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane and Rick Combs. Paul Campbell arrived at 9:15 a.m. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

**TEST DECK:**

At 9:05 a.m. the Board went off the Record to run the Test Deck. Rick and Dave observed the running of the Test Deck thru the 650 scanner. Tim read from the original (control) report while Dave checked the results from the newly run Test Deck and found the results to match and that the computer was counting accurately.

At 9:45 a.m. the Board went back on the Record.

**2014-50** – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the results of the Test Deck. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**ABSENTEE BALLOTS:**

Director Miller reviewed the breakdown of the Absentee Ballots with the Board. There were a total of 3,256 absentee ballots issued - 3,002 were counted/returned on Election Day (plus 1 ballot needs to be reviewed by the Board) - 253 ballots were not returned. She stated that the voters who had returned Ballots with deficiencies were properly and promptly notified, allowing them the chance to correct the deficiencies that would prevent their Ballot from being counted.

**INVALID ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

35 – Refused by nursing home voters-requested but not voted

2 – No Secrecy envelope

3 – No valid ID – voters were notified

1 – No stub

2 – Blank ID envelope – voters were notified

4 – No date of birth – voters were notified

1 – Absentee returned to the polls – found in the over-the-counter bag on Election Night

2 – No postmark date

8 – Postmarked Election Day (May 6, 2014 or after)

**2014-51** – Rick Combs made the motion to reject the 58 Absentee Ballots reviewed by the Board and identified by the staff as “Invalid.” Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**VALID ABSENTEE BALLOTS**

- 1 – Printed signature on ID envelope (signature on file) – Board discussed and accepted- voter is to fill out a new Registration Card
- 7 – Postmarked before Election Day (May 6, 2014) and received within 10 days

**2014-52** – Paul Campbell made the motion to accept the 8 additional Valid Absentee Ballots and add them to the count. Rick Combs seconded the motion.

**PROVISIONAL BALLOTS**

Director Miller reviewed the Provisional Ballots with the Board. She stated that there were 159 provisional ballots issued.

**INVALID PROVISIONAL BALLOTS**

- 2 – Voter did not sign the front of the envelope
- 1 – Voted in the wrong precinct/wrong location
- 4 – Not registered in Ohio

**2014-53** – Rick Combs made the motion to reject the 7 Provisional Ballots that were identified by the staff as being “Invalid” and reviewed by the Board. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**VALID PROVISIONAL BALLOTS**

- 150 – Valid Provisional Ballots
- 2 – Voted in the right polling location/wrong precinct

**2014-54** – Dave Lane made the motion accept the 152 valid Provisional Ballots as reviewed by the Board and identified by the staff, and “Add” them to the count. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**2014-55** – Rick Combs made the motion to instruct the office staff to proceed with the Official Canvass. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

At 10:20 the Board went off the Record to check on the Bills.

At 10:21 the Board went back on the Record and Judy stated that the bills would be prepared for the Regular Meeting.

**HHS Grant Fund for In-Person PEO Training for ADA Compliance:**

Judy explained that we applied for and received \$3,354.17 in grant money, \$5 per person for PEO Training and for Gregg Conrad training them. This comes from the Secretary of State’s Office ADA Program. This money goes back in the General Fund.

**2014 Summer Conference:**

Judy discussed the SOS Summer Conference. There are several locations and the closest for us would be on June 23<sup>rd</sup> at Hueston Woods from 9 am. to 4 pm. The cost is \$50 per person. Judy would like the entire staff to attend because these one day conferences cover a lot of information. We can have 2 part-time people staff the office that day. Judy contacted Croswell Bus Transportation and they would take us to and from the conference for \$515. Any Board Members need to let Judy know if they want to attend.

**2014-56** – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the bid for the transportation to and from the SOS Summer Conference held at Hueston Woods on June 23 for the entire staff and bring in 2 part-time staff (D & R) so the office is staffed properly. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

Judy reviewed Directive 2014-12 which states that we will not change a voter’s party status if they did not vote in the May 2014 Primary Election. Previously we would have changed a party status back to non-partisan if they didn’t vote in every primary election.

Dan Shebesta will be in on Friday to run election reports for Certification.

At 10:34 a.m. the Chairman stated the Board will stand in Recess and will Reconvene on May 27, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. to Certify the Election.

**Board Reconvenes**  
**Certification and Regular Meeting**  
**May 27, 2014, 10 a.m.**

The Board Reconvened and was back in Session on May 27, 2014 at 10:03 a.m. Rick Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Tim Rudd, Dave Lane, Rick Combs, and Paul Campbell. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

**OTHER ATTENDEES:** Kristin Rover – The Clermont Sun, Jeff Hirsh and cameraman – Channel 12 News arrived at 10:25 a.m.

**TEST DECK:**

At 10:03 a.m. the Board went off the Record to run the Test Deck. Judy advised the Board that Dan Shebesta (ES&S) ran the Test Deck on Friday and prepared the reports. Tim read from the original control sheet while Dave compared the results from the newly run Test Deck and found the results to match and that the computer was counting accurately.

At 10:15 a.m. the Board went back on the Record.

**2014-57** – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the Results of the Test Deck. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

After a review of the Official Election Results it was determined that there was one race that ended in a tie vote: Republican County Central Committee Member – Union U1U. There were 3 candidates and 2 candidates tied. The Official Results determined that Carol Addi Keim and Jared T. Martin each received 18 votes and Judith Kelch received 9 votes. Per Directive 2014-12, prior to certifying any election results,

the Board must break any ties by lot. The Board elected to declare the winner by a coin toss. Board Chairman Tim Rudd flipped a coin and Board Member Dave Lane called "tails" for Addie Keim. The coin landed on "heads" and Jared T. Martin was the declared winner. Paul Campbell inquired about the difference between the totals of the Write-In Candidates. Judy explained that she gave the Board a copy of the Certified Total Results for the Write-In Candidates which is different from the computer printout totals. It is very difficult to change/manipulate the totals from the computer results and should not be done that way.

**CERTIFICATION OF THE MAY 6, 2014 PRIMARY ELECTION:**

**2014-58** – Rick Combs made the motion to Certify the Results of the May 6, 2014 Primary Election. Dave Lane seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes". (See attached.)

Jeff Hirsh –Channel 12 New entered the meeting (10:25 am).

**Recounts:**

Judy stated that the only automatic recount was for the tie vote for the Union Township U1U Central Committee Member.

**2014-59** – Dave Lane made the motion to set the Automatic Recount for Union U1U for June 3, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

The Board entered in the Regular Monthly Board Meeting.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**2014-60** – Paul Campbell made the motion to approve the minutes of the April 23, 2014 Regular Board Meeting. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

**APPROVAL OF BILLS:**

**2014-61** – Dave Lane made the motion to accept and pay the bills. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

**DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

Director Miller reported that no entities filed for an August Special Election. The filing deadline was May 5<sup>th</sup>.

She stated that she has started working on Precinct Election Official (PEO) recruitment. Our base of PEO workers is getting smaller. She spoke at a PERS Meeting and is trying to get the word out about being a PEO.

DIMS-NeT is having their Annual Seminar July 24 & 25 in Perrysville at the Mohican State Park. The reservations are due by May 30<sup>th</sup>. Judy went over topics that would be covered and stated that she would like Jackie Smith, Bonnie Carlier, Stephanie Haight, Tonia Blackburn and herself to go. The cost of the lodging is \$125 per person.

**2014-62** – Dave Lane made the motion to send up to five employees identified by the Director and Deputy Director to the DIMS-NeT Conference in July. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted "yes".

**DEPUTY DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

Deputy Director Keeley reported that the deployment went very well with no problems and the price was reasonable. We have already reserved this crew for the November Election.


