At 7:01 a.m. the Board went back on the record.

2014-103 – Dave Lane made the motion to duplicate the absentee ballots that the Board determined necessary to duplicate. Rick Combs seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

2014-104 – Rick Combs made the motion to allow the staff to work split shifts on the day after the election (11-5-2014) per direction from the Director and Deputy Director. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

Judy advised the Board that tomorrow, November 5, 2014 at 4:00 p.m. is the filing deadline for a February 3, 2015 Special Election. To date there have been no filings.

Tim asked if there had been any problems this morning. Judy stated that it was going pretty smooth only minor issues. She did state that some of the diverters in the M100 cans were sticking. The stands are getting old and it doesn't flip the ballots the way they should. Tim asked if the BCC has said what their intentions are when they lose the storage space. Judy stated that they had not and we have not heard back from Wade Grabowski (Facilities).

At 7:05 a.m. the Chairman stated the Board will stand in Recess and will Reconvene at 5:30 p.m.

At 6:01 p.m. the Board came out of Recess and went back on the Record.

The Board ran the Test Deck and at 6:01 and went back off the Record while they reviewed the additional absentee ballots that required Board determination.

2014-107 – Rick Combs made the motion to accept the Unofficial Results of the November 4, 2014 General Election and forward those results to the Secretary of State. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

At 10:11 p.m. the Board went off the Record to run the Test Deck.
At 10:19 p.m. the Board went back on the Record.

Tim and Dave compared the Results of the Final Test Deck and found the totals of the newly run Test Deck to match the results on the control sheet and that the computer was counting accurately.


