

Chairman Rick Combs called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Ray Lembke led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Rick Combs, Paul Campbell, Larry Heller, and Ray Lembke. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director, and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

**MOTION TO ADOPT THE AGENDA AS PRESENTED:**

**2016-61** – Paul Campbell made the motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Larry Heller seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

Director Miller explained what happened after Certification. While we were re-checking reports after Certification the numbers were off; five precincts did not balance. The precincts that were off were re-run (ballots) and put on the same disk as other ballots that needed to be added to the count. Those five precincts were added to the count instead of being replaced. Those should have been on two separate disks. This error caused no changes in any election contests.

Rick verified that we reported this to the Secretary of State and he knows what is going on. Judy stated that we corrected the reports to them and they understand what happened. Rick wants it on the Record that we understand how it worked; totally open about how it worked and he understands it.

Paul asked at what point could we have picked this up. Judy said sometimes things happen in a rush and we had so many variables to account for ie. curbside voters, late voters, 17 year old voters, emergency slot ballots etc. Judy instructed that each group of ballots will be scanned on separate disks from now on.

**2016-62** – Ray Lembke made the motion to accept the Results of the Test Deck that was run after the Amended Official Count Results were Recorded (as verified by the Director and Deputy Director) – that the computer was counting accurately (note: Test Deck was run and approved following the Recording of the Original Official Election Results and the Unity Computer System was not run since that time.). Larry Heller seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

**RE-CERTIFICATION OF THE MARCH 15, 2016 PRIMARY ELECTION:**




