

Chairman Rick Combs called the meeting to order at 6:30 a.m. Paul Campbell led the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members present were Rick Combs, Paul Campbell, Larry Heller, and Ray Lembke. Also present were Judy Miller – Director, Mike Keeley – Deputy Director, and Becky Rudd – Clerk taking record.

Open Polls:

Rick Combs declared the Polls open.

MOTION TO ADOPT THE AGENDA AS PRESENTED:

2016-30 – Ray Lembke made the motion to adopt the agenda as presented. Larry Heller seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS FOR BOARD REVIEW:

Director Miller explained what absentee ballots required Board review. The ballots to be reviewed for Voter Intent included Over Voted, Write-Ins, Torn or Defective Ballots and Blank Ballots.

At 6:36 a.m. the Board went off the Record to review the ballots.

At 7:23 a.m. the Board went back on the Record after reviewing the ballots.

2016-31 – Larry Heller made the motion to duplicate the absentee ballots that were indicated to need duplication which included the torn or defective ballots that will not run through the 850 Ballot Scanner, the ballots that need duplicated due to stray markings and those that need duplicated due to the fact that the ovals were not properly marked. The Board determined the voter intent and added them to the count. Paul Campbell seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

2016-32 – At 7:23 a.m. Paul Campbell made the motion to go off the Record but stay in Session and Reconvene at 5:30 p.m. Ray Lembke seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

At 7:23 a.m. the Board stands in Recess.

At 5:55 p.m. the Board Reconvened and went back on the Record.

At 5:55 p.m. Rick stated the Board would go off the Record while they ran the Test Deck.

At 6:05 p.m. the Board went back on the Record.

TEST DECK:

Rick read from the control sheet while Ray compared the results from the newly run Test Deck and found the results to match and the computer was counting accurately.

2016-33 – Ray Lembke made the motion to accept the Results of the Test Deck. Larry Heller seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.

At 6:06 p.m. the Chairman stated that the Board would go back off the Record until the polls closed at 7:30 pm.

At approximately 7:35 p.m., Director Judy Miller reported to the Board that she had just received a phone call from a gentleman in the 6th Circuit Court of Appeals Office of Judge Dlott advising that the Judge had issued an Order to keep the Election Polls open an additional hour (until 8:30 p.m.) in Clermont, Hamilton, Warren and Butler Counties due to a traffic accident on the Combs-Hehl Bridge that crosses the Ohio River at I275 and Kellogg. Judy said she advised the gentleman that the Board of Elections can only take directions from the Ohio Secretary of State and we would have to wait until we received an order from them. Judy gave the phone numbers for the Secretary of State’s Office and Matt Damschroder’s cell phone to the gentleman. At 7:40 p.m. Judy called Pat Curry at the SOS’s Office to find out if there was a legitimate Court Order to keep the Polls Open and she was advised that the SOS Office was going to honor the Court Order. Judy was advised that a Directive would be issued shortly and to follow the Directive. Directive 2016-09 was issued and received by the Clermont County Board of Elections at approximately 8:04 p.m. Phone calls were attempted to be made to the Voting Location Managers at all Polling Locations after 7:40 p.m. to advise them to keep the Polls Open until 8:30 p.m. per the Court Order.

At 10:42 p.m. the Board went back on the Record.

Director Miller reported that all Absentee and Election Day Ballots, including the emergency slot and curbside voter ballots, had been tabulated and we now have the Unofficial Election Results.

2016-34 – Ray Lembke made the motion to accept the Unofficial Results of the March 15, 2016 Primary Election and send copies to the Secretary of State and most populous Counties in the 2nd Congressional District, and the 12th District Court of Appeals as required by Directive 2016-06. Larry Heller seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.
The Board signed all required reports.

2016-35 – Larry Heller made the motion to allow the staff to work split shifts on the day after the election (March 16) – half coming in from 8:00 a.m. until 12:30 (Tonia, Becky, Kim, Jackie) and the other half coming in from 12 noon until 4:30 p.m. (Bonnie, Terrie, Stephanie). Ray Lembke seconded the motion. Upon roll call, all Members voted “yes”.
