He was sent a registration card after the November 2016 Election but has not returned the card. We recommend that this ballot not be counted.

Larry added that we have identified flaws in the design of the provisional ballot envelope and asked if we should send this information to the Secretary of State. Judy stated that they are aware of it.

He said it is something to think about to not pay them if they do not show up to work. Julia has concerns about the Fair Labor Standards Act. We will look into it with Mary Lynne Birck.
