Saturday, March 24 the UOCAVA absentee ballots must be ready to go (45 days before the Primary), limited staff will be here by 10:00 a.m. to pick up mail. Some of the ballots will be mailed and some are emailed. To date we have 24 requests.

**B.** April 9, is the close of voter registration, we will have extended office hours (8 am - 9 pm). To date we have 138,072 registered voters.

To date we have a total of 218 absentee ballot requests (194 + 24 UOCAVA). The numbers seem to be dropping in the primaries (within our county).

Early voting starts on April 10, with extended hours: 8-5, the last week of voting 8-7, Saturday before the election 8-4, Sunday 1-5 and Monday 8-2.
