Mr. Conrad asked about the issues with the ballots having only one stub, which did not work well at the polling locations. Director Carney responded that we will go back to two stubs going forward.

Director Carney noted that the list of bills was correct with the exception that the extra Millennium copier monthly lease will be paid out of the CARES grant.
