Director Hemmer-Haight reviewed the petitions of the candidates listed above. Upon discussion of Mr. Coogan’s petition, the board concluded that the illegible signature (two signatures written over each other) could not be counted. Going forward, the voter may update his signature if his stroke has caused it to change substantially.

The board noted that walking lists of registered voters by precinct are available on our website. Before submitting a petition, a candidate may avoid the issue of insufficient signatures by comparing the list of voters who signed the petition against the applicable walking list(s).

Regarding the petitions that were missing the “Petition for Candidate” section, Mr. Lembke reminded the board of the Ohio Supreme Court decision setting the precedent that both parts of the petition are required and must be completed prior to obtaining signatures. This is a strict compliance point; but for this ruling, the board would be inclined to accept petitions with the sole error being an omission of information duplicated elsewhere.

Several of the candidates listed their township instead of the “City or Village” included in their mailing address. Mr. Lembke commented that the township of residence is actually more relevant in clarifying whether the candidate is eligible to run in their precinct than a city such as Cincinnati that spans multiple counties and townships. Ms. Dennison’s residence is clear from her address on the petition, despite the zip code omission.

Deputy Director Dennison reminded the board that the SOS requires a board vote, submission of quality assurance documentation, and SOS authorization for each election for which the board intends to outsource the printing and mailing of absentee ballots, regardless of whether a vendor contract remains in place. Mr. Combs asked if we are still saving money by using the mail house. Deputy Director Dennison indicated that we will actually save additional money because we will be contracting directly with the printing company instead of going through a third party; the mail house quote decreased from \$2.05 per packet to \$1.90/packet.

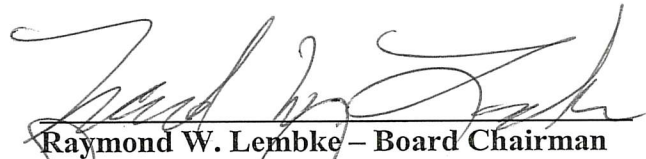

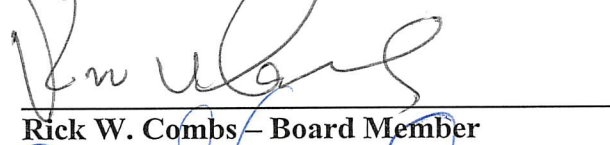

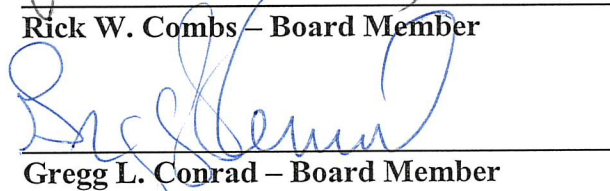
