Council Minutes
November 28, 2022

The meeting opened at 7:00 pm.

Members present were President Doris Kemner, Carl Habrick, Larry Sines, Joe Orban, Bonnie Peters, Greg Michalak and Bill Sherman.

There were no public comments.

Joe Orban joined meeting at 7:05 pm.

Council briefly discussed vehicular and pedestrian traffic on Sunset Drive. Staff will be presenting the 2023 Street Capital Improvement Plan at the December meeting which will include maintenance of that street.

Motion by Sines and seconded by Habrick to authorize \$2,500 for PM Blough to prepare a park grant application for a pickle ball court facility at Tate Park. Motion carried unanimously.

President Kemner provided an update on the December 3, 2022, Christmas in the Village event.

Motion by Sines seconded by Sherman to go into closed session, pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, to consider the purchase of energy and capacity. Motion carried unanimously with a roll call vote. Closed session started at 7:33 pm.

Motion by Habrick and seconded by Sines to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
