Council Minutes  
May 16, 2022

The meeting opened at 7:02 pm.

Members Present were President Doris Kemner, Carl Habrick, Larry Sines, Joe Orban, and Greg Michalak. Bonnie Peters and Kevin Kelly were absent.

Motion was made by Orban and seconded by Sines to adopt Resolution 2022-10, a resolution to adopt the MDOT Road Construction Grant. Motion carried unanimously.

Council decided to table the 2022 DWSRF Grant Application, which could provide a low interest loan/grant for water system improvements. It will be looked at again in 2023.

The Village Manager provided an update on the Sunset drainage situation.

A motion was made by Sines and seconded by Habrick to go into closed session, pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, to discuss the possible purchase of energy and capacity. Motion was approved unanimously with a roll call vote.

Closed session began at 7:10 pm.

A motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Sines to go back into open session. Motion carried unanimously.

Open session began at 8:25 pm.

A motion was made by Orban and seconded by Michalak to authorize the Village Manager to commit the Village to the solar project as proposed by the MSCPA for 0.6 MW. Motion carried five to one with Sines voting no.

Member Habrick made mention of the increasing traffic on Tecumseh Road.

A motion was made by Habrick and seconded by Michalak to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
