

Village of Clinton
Council Minutes
April 15, 2024

The meeting opened at 7:04 pm.

Members present were President Doris Kemner, President Pro-Tem Larry Sines, Joe Orban, Bonnie Peters, Greg Michalak, and David Clark. Bill Sherman was absent.

Additions to the agenda included Mobile Food Truck Application.

Village Manger provided an overview of the Waste Water Treatment Plant's base costs and variable costs.

Council and Village Manager discussed options for a sewer rate increase to fund the operation and maintenance of the plant.

Village Manager discussed water and sewer connection fees.

Village Clerk provided information on the Lead Service Line Notification Letters that get sent to residents.

Village Manager provided an overview of the draft 2024 Street Construction Notice that will be mailed to residents that will be directly affected by the Sunset Drive, Colebrook Drive and East Franklin Street construction project.

Information on National Day of Prayer was provided and Council felt it was best to keep the separation between church and state.

Motion by Orban seconded by Peters to approve the solicitor's application and fee structure for food trucks as amended.

Motion by Orban seconded by Michalak to increase the penalty fee from \$75.00 to \$150.00 for soliciting without a permit.

Village Manager provided an update on the power outage due to DTE's faulty distribution system.

Council Member Peters mentioned that the Semi-Annual River Raisin Water Shed meeting will be Thursday, April 18, 2024. The topic that will be discussed is Bee Keeping.

President Kemner mentioned that she attended a meeting about dementia friendly communities. She also had a meeting with Lenawee Now and the United States Department of Agriculture looking for grant opportunities for the Village.

Motion by Orban seconded by Sines to go into closed session, pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, to discuss energy and capacity. Motion carried unanimously with a roll call vote. Closed session started at 8:53 pm.

Motion by Orban and seconded by Sines to go into open session. Motion carried unanimously. Open session started at 9:06 pm.

Motion by Michalak and seconded by Peters to adopt Resolution Number 2024-08 Pertaining to AMP Contract No. 2024-9977-SCHED for solar energy. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Sines and seconded by Peters to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
