

Village of Clinton
Council Minutes
March 4, 2024

The meeting opened at 7:03 pm.

Members present were President Doris Kemner, President Pro-Tem Larry Sines, Joe Orban, Greg Michalak and David Clark. Bonnie Peters and Bill Sherman phoned in.

Village Manager added Resolution Number 2024-05 for charitable gaming license for the Clinton wrestling club.

Motion by Sines seconded by Michalak to approve the regular Council minutes dated February 5, 2024, special Council minutes and closed Council minutes dated February 12, 2024. Motion carried unanimously.

The Bobcat mini excavator and Mack dump truck were available for viewing at the Village Office.

Chief Tony Cuvas received a meritorious service award for solving a 32-year cold case.

Motion by Orban seconded by Sines to approve the checks written for period ending February 29, 2024. Motion carried unanimously.

Village Clerk mentioned that ten athletes received scholarships from donated funds to play soccer during the spring season.

Motion by Sines seconded by Clark to authorize the sale of the 1995 Ford dump truck, the used wing plow and the used York rake. Motion carried unanimously.

Village Manager provided an updated pickleball court layout.

Village Manager provided an updated street construction map.

Motion by Sines seconded by Michalak to adopt Resolution 2024-03 to authorize execution of the interlocal agreement with the Washtenaw Area Mutual Aid Council. Motion carried unanimously.

Council discussed applying for a state Recreation Passport Grant to help fund expansion of the Tate Park paved pathway and fishing/observation deck. There were no public comments on the grant application.

Motion by Sines seconded by Orban to adopt Resolution 2024-04 to apply for the Recreation Passport Grant Program for extending the Tate Park paved pathway with a fishing/observation dock on the river, and authorize the Village to match without donated funds. Motion carried unanimously.

Village Manager provided an update on the draft 2024-25 budget.

Village Manager explained the need for a sewer rate increase.

Motion by Michalak seconded by Sines to receive and file the Council Information Package. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Orban seconded by Sines to adopt Resolution 2024-05, a resolution for charitable gaming license for the Clinton Wrestling Club. Motion carried unanimously.

President Pro-Tem Sines asked about Tate Park's dog waste bags and Brush Pickup. Brush pickup is the first and third Thursday of the month beginning in April.

Council Member Clark asked about the clearing of trees along the Tate Park island pathway.

Council Member Michalak asked about an update for the generator.

Motion by Orban and seconded by Sines to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously.
