Garbage Pick-Up & Recycling

Service is provided by Stevens Disposal & Recycling. Trash is collected every Friday and recycling is every other Friday. Items must be out by 6:00 a.m. Additional item tags can be purchased at the Village office, \$10.00 per bulk/large item or \$1.50 per extra bag.

Composting & Wood Chips

The Village provides a composting and wood chip/mulch program to Village residents. The compost pile is located on Bartlett St. West of Railroad St. and is available for grass clippings and leaf drop-off; no twigs, branches, bags, or items that will not decompose. Composted soil is available for residents at no cost if individuals pick it up at the compost site. Limit to 1 wheelbarrow load.

For wood chip delivery, agreements can be made with our DPW department to deliver a load of wood chips if coordinated with our brush chipping schedule. Contact DPW via phone at (517) 456-7494 x1216 or email dpw@villageofclinton.org

Brush, Leaf, & Christmas Tree Collection

Brush pick-up: First and third Thursday, April through October, weather and staff permitting. Brush or tree branches must be less than four inches in diameter. It must be placed in the yard by the curb for easy access, but not placed in the street. It must be cut in neat, compact, lightweight bundles of no longer than four feet that can be easily picked-up by one person and placed in a truck or chipper. Do not tie the bundles. No more than seven bundles per parcel of property each pick-up. Commercial contractors are responsible for disposing of any tree and brush cut from a homeowner's property. Property owners are responsible for disposing of any tree roots and trees they trim or cut down that have more than seven bundles of brush.

Leaf collection: Throughout the month of November. Place all piles of leaves in the street by the curb.

Real Christmas trees: Picked-up in January. Tree stands must be removed before placing by the curb.

Smith Kimball Community Center

The Greek Revival style home built in 1840 was graciously donated to the Village in 1955 by Mrs. L. Kimball. The home was converted into a community center and serves as a social center for area groups.
