Call to Order

Motion to open the Colmar Manor Mayor & Town Council meeting at 6:00 PM. Motion by Councilmember Hobbs, second Councilmember Harding. Vote 4-0. Motion passed.

Discussion of potential projects priority list to assist in seeking grant funding

The council discussed potential project ideas to provide the town lobbyist while they seek funding for the town. These projects included:

- Spanish and English language classes
- Business grants and coordinator including training workshops like social media presence for example.
- Development opportunities for kids, such as summer programming. Possible theater camp, basketball camp, activities not just babysitting.
- Tennis sessions with coach with different age groups.
- New town street signs clarification- street names, but also new town signs. Including lighting for town signs. Town entrance structure.
- Facilities and equipment for public works is very important.
- Clarification on outreach. How to keep children updated? Dr. Betty- outreach.
 - Youth council development to bring forward more experiences for the youth.
- Opportunity to volunteer for kids. Expanding that program and a volunteer coordinator. Better mechanism to refer to volunteers, coordinate a positive experience when they volunteer, good opportunity to coordinate the youth council.
 - Monthly clean-up
- Arts and humanities- children's activities for welcome packet
- Asked about walkway to Anacostia trail, contacting Delegate Ivey regarding raising the levy.
- Stormwater issues, upfront funding to assist residents.
 - Green and natural stormwater management
 - Coordination with county.
 - Lawrence overflow ditch flooding
