The credit card holder contacted the victim to advise that they never ordered tires and that an unknown offender had stolen the credit card number to place the order. A suspect was taken in to custody when they arrived to pick up the order. The investigation is on-going and has revealed that this activity had occurred several previous times.

Officers located the vehicle driving south on LaGrange Road at 55 th Street. The vehicle fled at a high rate of speed when a traffic stop was attempted. The vehicle was last seen driving north on I-55 from LaGrange Road at a high rate of speed on the right shoulder.
