8-4-23	5:51 PM	11 Countryside Plaza, Best Buy	Forgery, Assault	The complainant reported that an offender attempted to make a purchase using five (5) counterfeit \$100 bills. The complainant told the offender that the bills were fake. The offender demanded the bills back and when the complainant refused the offender threatened him. The offender was described as a male black 5ft 11in, medium build, wearing a white hat, white hoodie, red sweatpants, and a white surgical mask. The offender left the area in a silver Chrysler 300.
8-5-23	10:31 PM	9800 block of Joliet Road	Aggravated Assault	The victim reported that teenagers wearing black hooded sweatshirts flashed gang signs at him. The victim then began to follow the offenders and argued with them. During the argument the victim reported that one of the offenders pointed a black handgun at him. The victim then walked away and the offenders left the area on foot.
8-6-23	8:56 PM	5403 LaGrange Road, Tavern on LaGrange	Battery	The victim stated that prior to making the report she was punched in the face and body by an offender described as a "family friend". The victim and offender had both left the area prior to making the report.

Brainard, TJ Maxx	Retail Theft	A loss prevention employee from the store observed two offenders remove the security sensors from approximately \$989.00 worth of bed sheets and steal them from the store. One offender was described as a female black wearing a pink hat, black shirt, and black pants. The second offender was described as a male black wearing a black hat, black shirt, and black sweatpants. The offenders left in a white cargo van. Per his company policy the loss prevention employee waited for the offenders to leave the area prior to contacting police.
8-7-23	7:37 PM	6400 block Joliet Road	Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle, Fleeing and Eluding	Officers received an alert from a license plate reader of a stolen Kia sedan driving in the area. An officer observed the vehicle in the 6400 block of Joliet Road. The offending vehicle immediately fled at a high rate of speed when the driver observed a police car in the area. Officers attempted to use stop sticks on the offending vehicle at LaGrange Road and 63 <sup>rd</sup> Street but the vehicle drove into oncoming traffic to avoid them. The vehicle was last seen driving south on LaGrange Road from 67 <sup>th</sup> Street.

The vehicle was last seen driving south on LaGrange Road at a high rate of speed driving in and out of oncoming traffic to pass cars.
