The victim related to the officer that while she was shopping inside the store an unknown offender stole her wallet. The wallet was inside a backpack the victim left unattended in her shopping cart. It was later determined that one of the credit cards from the wallet was used in an attempt to make a fraudulent purchase at the Sam's Club in Hodgkins, IL shortly after the theft.
