7-7-23	9:56 AM	9665 55 th Street, Avis Rental Car	Motor Vehicle Report	An employee reported that a customer rented a car on 4-26-23. The car was due to be returned on 5-18-23. The customer never returned the car and declined all attempts from the business to communicate with them. The car was located in a parking lot in Hammond, Indiana unlocked with the keys inside.
7-7-23	7:39 PM	5400 block Madison	Disorderly Conduct / Assault	The victim reported that they were in an argument about a parking spot. During the course of the argument the offender told a third party to go get a gun so they could shoot the victim.
7-10-23	4:22 AM	6301 Joliet Road, Rolling Lanes	Burglary	The victim called police from home after waking up to remotely check the surveillance cameras at the business and observing that the gaming machines were damaged. The responding officers found that the front door had been broken into and the business was burglarized. A further review of the video showed that at 3:37 AM three offenders in dark colored hooded sweatshirts broke into the business. They used a crow bar, sledgehammer, and a drill to break into the gaming machines. An unknown amount of currency and liquor was taken. The offenders were observed leaving the area at 4:05 AM in a dark colored sedan.
7-10-23	12:59 PM	5401 Dansher Road, Perfect Aire	Disorderly Conduct	An unknown offender called the business to complain about an air conditioner they purchased. When the business declined to refund the offender, the offender threatened to "blow the place up". The caller ID indicated that the offender was likely in Minnesota. The complainant declined to prosecute the offender if he was identified.
7-10-23	1:30 PM	9500 block 56 th Street	Forgery	The victim reported that they own a property in the City of Chicago. On 7/10/23 they received an email from a property management company that someone was attempting to sublease their property. The victim determined that the offender forged the victim's signature on paperwork that was submitted to complete the sublease process. The offender used an address in North Carolina and a bank account in Georgia during the attempt.
