7-16-23	8:17 PM	9825 W. 55 th Street, CFX Gym	Theft	The victim reported that they left their wallet in an unlocked locker while they showered. When they returned to the locker after showering, their wallet was gone. It was later found that credit cards which were inside the stolen wallet had been fraudulently used in Palos Heights, IL.
7-16-23	1:30 PM	9901 58 th Street, Ideal Park	Criminal Defacement	An officer conducting a check of the park was flagged down by a citizen. The citizen informed the officer that they observed four (4) juveniles in the drainage area on the south side of the park. The citizen stated that juveniles ran away when they saw the citizen walking towards them. The officer proceeded to the area where the juveniles were observed and observed graffiti on the walls of the drainage area and a fence in the area.

7-17-23	11:30 AM	5631 LaGrange Road, Ettleson Hyundai	Disorderly Conduct, Criminal Damage to Property	Employees of the business related that they believe an offender is shooting at dealership employees and vehicles are being shot at with a pellet or BB gun. They reported an incident on 7-14-23 where an employee believed that pellets or BB's were shot in close vicinity to him as well as an incident approximately 2 weeks prior where a car window was damaged by what was believed to be a pellet or BB. The vehicle in question had already been repaired and sold prior to the report being made.
7-17-23	2:12 PM	7000 block of Lorraine Drive	Theft	The victim reported that they paid \$80 to purchase event tickets from the offender via social media. When they arrived at the event in Chicago they were denied entry due to the tickets being fake. The victim declined to prosecute the offender if they were to be identified.
7-17-23	6:15 PM	6600 block of Brainard Avenue	Identity Theft	The victim reported that they placed an online order with a company on 7-4-23. The item they ordered never arrived. The victim found a phone number on Google which they believed was the company and called it to inquire about the order. The person the victim spoke with on the phone directed the victim to download an app to their phone. The victim downloaded the app and entered her information into it. The victim also sent the offender \$500 via the Zelle payment app. After sending the money, the victim realized they were being scammed and successfully cancelled the transaction. As of the time of the report there was no financial loss and the victim declined to prosecute the offender if he was identified.

The damage appeared to be have been caused by an unknown offender shooting a BB gun at the windshield.

Holguin, M/19 yoa, Brookfield, IL	<p>While conducting a check of the business a patrol officer observed a suspicious vehicle drive out of the rear parking lot behind the business. When the vehicle observed the squad car, it turned off its headlights and began running stop signs prior to the officer activating his emergency lights and siren.</p> <p>Once the officer activated his lights and sirens, the vehicle refused to stop and continued to flee until it crashed into the parkway in the 5800 block of LaGrange Road.</p> <p>One (1) of the vehicle occupants immediately surrendered and four (4) other occupants of the vehicle fled on foot. With the assistance of the LaGrange Police Department, LaGrange Park Police Department, and a Cook County Sheriff's Police Department K9 all 4 of the subjects that fled on foot were located and arrested.</p> <p>Holguin was determined to be the driver of the fleeing vehicle. He was charged with Aggravated Fleeing and Eluding in addition to traffic citations. He was held until he could be transported for a bond hearing.</p> <p>Three of the occupants that fled from the vehicle were charged with local ordinance violations for the possession of fake or fictitious identification cards. The occupant of the vehicle that immediately surrendered was released without charges.</p>

Anderson, F/19 yoa, Chicago, IL	Officers were alerted that a stolen car was driving in the area based on License Plate Reader (LPR) cameras in LaGrange Park and in Countryside. While checking the area they located the vehicle backed in to a parking spot at Home Depot. Anderson was seated in the passenger seat of the vehicle. Anderson related that a friend had driven the car to Home Depot and went inside the store. She refused to provide any further information about his identity or description. Tools and items consistent with the vehicle being involved in catalytic converter thefts were also found in the stolen vehicle. Anderson was arrested without incident. After the Cook County State's Attorney's Office declined to file felony charges against Anderson she was charged with misdemeanor Criminal Trespass to a Motor Vehicle and released on bond.

Lollar Jr., M/23 yoa, Chicago, IL	On 7-16-23 at approximately 9:14 PM an officer took a report of a bike theft that occurred at 5330 LaGrange Road. The theft was caught on surveillance video and images of the offender were disseminated to the police department. On 7-17-23 an officer observed the offender pictured in the surveillance video riding a bike in the 6100 block of Joliet Road. The offender, now identified as Lollar, was arrested without incident and later released on bond.
