6-10-23	12:05 PM	5701 LaGrange Road, McDonald's	Hit and Run	The victim reported that while he was inside the restaurant a witness approached him and told him that a tan colored minivan struck the victim's parked vehicle. The license plate information provided by the witness did not match the description of the offending vehicle.
6-10-23	2:23 PM	6704 Joliet Road, Tony's Fresh Market	Theft	An employee of the store reported that at approximately 12:00 PM a male black with a thin build wearing a white shirt and white shorts put \$602.96 worth of liquor in a shopping cart and left the store without paying for it. The suspect left the scene in a vehicle that had been reported stolen.
6-11-23	3:36 PM	6704 Joliet Road	Possession of a Stolen Motor Vehicle	Officers received an LPR alert for a stolen vehicle that was travelling through Countryside. They observed that the stolen vehicle had been used in a theft of liquor at Tony's the previous day (see above). Officers discretely followed the vehicle until it once again drove to Tony's. The vehicle was 'boxed in' by officers in the parking lot and all occupants were detained. The owner of the vehicle declined to press charges against the occupants with regard to the stolen car. Two occupants of the car were charged with other crimes (see arrest listing below).

The victim responded to an email they thought was Uber Eats and provided them with information regarding their business account. Shortly after responding to the email the victim was notified that their bank account information had been changed. The victim was able to notify their bank prior to any loss of funds.

Buchler was confronted by the parent of a child that was in the area when Buchler urinated. The responding officers noted that Buchler appeared to be highly intoxicated and spoke with witnesses before citing Buchler for public urination.
