The offender had already been identified and arrested previously for a theft which occurred on 4-14-23. The offender will be charged for the recently discovered thefts when he is located.
5-31-23	5:33 PM	Plainfield Road and 7 th Avenue	Aggravated Fleeing and Eluding, Traffic Violations	An officer observed a motorcycle operating on one wheel ("doing a wheelie") on Plainfield Road approaching LaGrange Road. As he drew closer to the vehicle, the officer observed that the vehicle was displaying a fictitious novelty license plate. When the officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop the motorcycle fled at a high rate of speed. Due to the high speeds and traffic conditions the officer did not initiate a vehicle pursuit.
