Ashland	Forgery	The victim reported that they received a call from their bank on 6/20/23 advising them that an unknown offender attempted to cash one of the victim's checks. The victim advised that they had placed the check in the mail on 6/19/23. The victim had already advised the post office of the apparent theft and indicated that they would decline to prosecute the offender if identified.

The offender was described as a male black, 25 yoa, 5ft 6in, thin build, wearing a green sweatshirt. The complainant indicated that they did not want to prosecute the offender if he was identified.
6-27-23	8:31 AM	6300 block Joliet Road	Attempted Motor Vehicle Theft	The victim reported that sometime between 12 AM - 8 AM an unknown offender(s) damaged the steering wheel and key cylinder on his parked vehicle in an apparent attempt to steal it. A witness later reported that at approximately 2:30 AM she heard loud noises from the parking lot. When she looked out she saw two people inside the victim's car with a flashlight, but did not contact police.

6-28-23	7:25 AM	9700 blk Lorraine Drive	Motor Vehicle Theft	The victim reported that he parked his car at 6 PM on 6-27-23 and left it unlocked with the keys inside. At 7:20 AM on 6-28-23 the victim noticed that his car was gone and called the police to report it stolen. It was determined that the car was involved in a vehicle pursuit in Livingston County at approximately 3 AM on 6-28-23. The Livingston County Sheriff had recovered the vehicle and impounded it after it was found to be unoccupied and abandoned somewhere in their jurisdiction.
6-28-23	12:32 PM	Joliet Road and Willow Springs Road	Aggravated Fleeing and Eluding	Officers received a notification from an LPR camera that there was a vehicle driving on Joliet Road with stolen license plates. They verified that the license plates were displayed on white Ford Focus sedan, but were supposed to be on a black Jeep SUV. When an officer located the vehicle and attempted a traffic stop it fled north on I-294. The driver was described as a male white in his late teens or early 20's with a thin build, and short dark hair.
6-28-23	3:44 PM	6400 blk Joliet Road	Motor Vehicle Theft	The victim reported that the offender applied for a job with their business on 6-27-23. On 6-28-23 the victim allowed the offender to borrow their car to run an errand. The offender was supposed to return the car within a few minutes, but never returned.
6-29-23	5:18 PM	5800 block LaGrange Road	Aggravated Fleeing and Eluding	Officers received an alert that a vehicle wanted by the Cook County Sheriff's Police was driving north on LaGrange Road. A LaGrange police officer observed the vehicle at the intersection of LaGrange Road and Plainfield Road. As soon as the driver observed the LaGrange police officer, the driver ran a red light and fled south on LaGrange Road. Countryside officers attempted to block the vehicle in as it became stuck in heavy traffic. The vehicle drove over the curb and parkway at a high rate of speed and fled. The vehicle was later recovered in Chicago and turned over to the Cook County Sheriff's Police for their investigation.

Jonya C. Vivetter, F/22 yoa, Chicago, IL	Officers received alerts from License Plate Reader (LPR) cameras of a stolen vehicle driving through Countryside. They located the vehicle backing in to a parking spot at Home Depot and used their squad cars to block it in. The driver of the vehicle struck a squad car and drove directly towards an officer forcing him to take cover behind his squad car. As the vehicle fled, it was observed that the front passenger tire of the stolen vehicle was damaged when it struck the squad car. A vehicle pursuit was terminated on I-294 due to the speeds and traffic conditions, however the Chicago Police Helicopter tracked the vehicle. The vehicle became disabled on the ramp from I-88 to I-290 due to the damage from the collision with the squad car. The four occupants of the vehicle fled, but were later taken in to custody following a multi-agency police response. Vivetter was determined to be the driver of the vehicle, charged accordingly, and held for a bond hearing.
