5-12-23	11:55 AM	52 Countryside Plaza, Cosmo Prof	Theft	\$446.92 worth of cosmetic products were discovered to have been stolen when employees conducted an inventory of the store merchandise. The theft is believed to have occurred between approximately 5-3-23 and 5-12-23. Employees were reviewing video surveillance to determine when the theft occurred and the description of the offenders.
5-12-23	4:35 PM	55 th Street and East Avenue	Hit and Run	A car crash occurred at the listed intersection. When the drivers stopped to speak, the offender offered the other driver cash. When the victim driver refused the cash and requested to exchange information the offender entered his vehicle and fled the scene. The offender has been tentatively identified and investigators are attempting to locate him pending charges.
5-13-23	7:45 AM	LaGrange Road and 63 rd Street	Aggravated Fleeing and Eluding, Stolen License Plates	Officers were alerted to a vehicle displaying stolen license plates driving west on 55 th Street from East Avenue. The vehicle was observed driving south on LaGrange Road at 63 rd Street. When the driver of the vehicle observed a police car stopped behind it, he fled at a high rate of speed. The pursuit was terminated due to safety reasons and the vehicle was last spotted fleeing in to Hinsdale.

It was later learned that the Chicago Police Department located and impounded the vehicle on 5-13-23 at approximately 7:35am after it crashed in the 2300 block of South Damen Avenue and the occupants fled.
