The victim observed two (2) subjects on a surveillance camera at the front door. The subjects were seen running south on Kensington Avenue from the residence. A light silver or white colored sedan was observed on video in the area at the time.

The investigation determined that the offender punched the victim in the face due to a remark the victim made to a bartender. The victim did not want to press criminal charges against the offender.

On arrival it was discovered that two (2) offenders smashed a window to the business to make entry and broke in to a single gaming machine.
