After helping the subject, she went to pay for her items and noticed her credit card was missing from her purse. The victim declined to prosecute the offender if they were identified.</p> <p><b>* Please be aware that this is a common tactic employed by thieves. They will attempt to distract a victim while a second offender removes personal items left in a shopping cart.</b></p>
9-30-23	2:00 PM	5800 blk of Longview Drive	Residential Burglary	<p>A resident reported that they left their residence in the morning and when they returned in the early afternoon, they discovered that their rear patio glass door had been shattered. Evidence technicians processed the house and recovered items that will be sent to the Illinois State Police Crime Lab for analysis. This case has been assigned to the Investigations Division and they are actively following up on additional leads.</p>
10-1-23	1:05 PM	5555 S. Brainard Avenue, TJ Maxx	Theft	<p>The complainant reported that while inside the store he noticed his cellular phone was missing. Officers are working with store management to review the video footage to determine if the theft occurred inside the store.</p>
