The approximate value of the stolen toys was \$150.00. The offender left the area in a small black SUV.

The victim suspects the offender(s) were the occupants of a gray sedan that were upset with the victim for taking a parking spot they were waiting for.

Plainfield Road	Attempted Burglary, Criminal Damage to Property	The victim reported that, between 4:30 PM on 2-13-24 and 7:24 AM on 2-14-24, an unknown offender(s) forced entry to storage areas and toolboxes at a construction site. At the time of the report, the victim did not observe anything missing.

Jewel / Huntington Bank	Attempted Theft by Deception	A white male between 30 – 50 years of age wearing a green shirt and blue jeans approached the victim and conducted a “dent repair scam”. The offender conned the victim into allowing him to “repair” a dent on the victim’s car by rubbing an unknown substance on the dent. The offender then convinced the victim that he owed the offender \$6500. The offender had the victim enter Jewel to withdraw the money from Huntington Bank while the offender waited outside. Alert tellers at Huntington Bank recognized something was wrong when the victim approached them, thus they refused to complete the transaction and called ‘911’. Officers searched the area for the offender, but he fled prior to their arrival. Thanks to the bank employees, there was no monetary loss.
