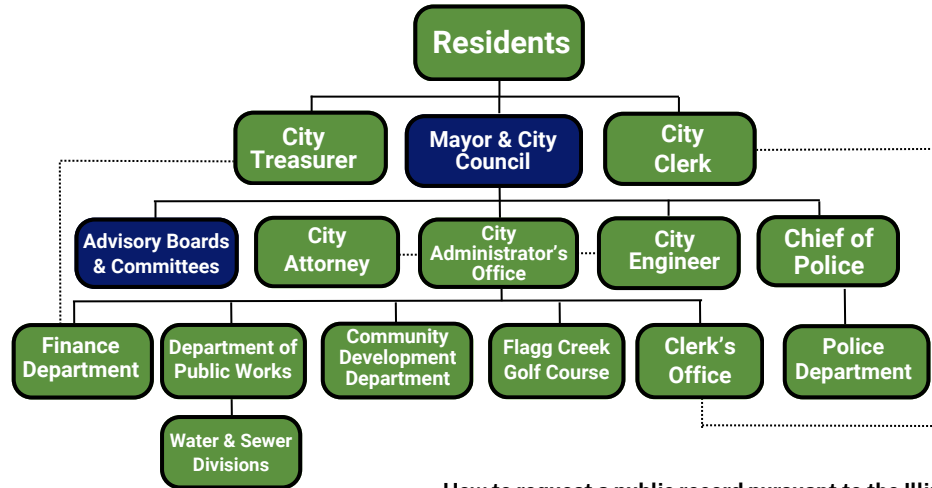

## Allowable Fees Under the FOIA (5 ILCS 140/6)

In certain circumstances, public entities may charge a fee for the production of public records. If 50 pages or less are copied and mailed to requestor there will be no charge. If the request exceeds 50 pages, we will notify the requestor that there is a copy fee of \$0.15 per page.
