



Five-Year Credit Enrollment by College




Credit Student Location 2018 Academic Year

Non-Credit Student Location 2018 Academic Year










10-15-21: DMACC Market Penetration

During AY 2019-20, DMACC enrolled 1,661 LDS Award Recipients. Of them, 222 were under the age of 20 (13%) and 1,439 (87%) were 20 years old or older.

Fall 2020 enrollment presented 1,212 LDS Recipients in DMACC, with 285 (23.5%) under age of 20 and 927 (76.5%) age 20 and over.



Amazon Employees Come to DMACC

'Career Choice is an education benefit that empowers employees to learn new skills for career success at Amazon or elsewhere. We meet individual learners where they are on their education journey through a variety of education and upskilling opportunities including full college tuition, industry certifications designed to lead to in-demand jobs, and foundational skills such as English language proficiency, high school diplomas, and GEDs.'

More excitement in process:

- a. We are talking to Amazon about being their lead education provider for employees wanting to take advantage of Amazon's tuition program.
- We met with Google and their program manager from India to be one of only two community colleges in the U.S. to pilot a new software engineering certificate they are developing. Decision in January.
- We met with TESLA about being a training site for TESLA technicians. They are building their business case for expansion.


